REVOKED

(HERBERT STREET, PONTARDAWE)

(REVOCATION AND PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER, 1968

The Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 (1), (2) and (3) and Section 2 (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, and of all other powers then enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

1. The provisions contained in "The Glamorgan County Council (Herbert Street, Pontardawe) (Limitation and Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1961 are hereby revoked.
2. Save as provided in Article 4 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable, in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at any time prohibited in the said Schedule.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in the lengths of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary:-
 - (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) to enable goods to be loaded onto or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near to the said length of road of any sewer or main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878;
 - (d) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said length of road;
 - (e) to enable any vehicle owned by a funeral director or owner of funeral vehicles to be used as part of a funeral cortage or otherwise in connection with a funeral;
 - (f) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
4. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, or by or under any other enactment.
5. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
6. This Order shall come into operation on the 31st day of May, 1968 and may be cited as "The Glamorgan County Council (Herbert Street, Pontardawe) (Revocation and Prohibition of Waiting) Order, 1968.

SCHEDULE

LEGISLATION OF ROAD

- (1) The northern side of
Herbert Street, Pontardawe
from its junction with High
Street to its junction with
Holly Street, Pontardawe.
- (2) The southern side of Herbert Street
Pontardawe from its junction with
High Street to a point opposite
the boundary of No's 45/47 Herbert
Street.
- (3) The northern side of Herbert Street
Pontardawe from the junction with
Holly Street to the level crossing.
- (4) The whole of the southern side of
Herbert Street, Pontardawe, with the
exception of the two lay-bys there-
in, from a point opposite the
boundary of No.'s 45/47 Herbert Street
to the level crossing.
- (5) The two lay-bys in the southern
side of Herbert Street,
Pontardawe.
