The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the link lanes between Cimla Road and Moorland Road other than in the direction shown below:-

Lane at Cimla Hotel

From Cimla Road to Moorland Road.

Lane at Post Office (between Nos. 121 and 123 Cimla Road)

From Moorlands Road to Cimla Road.

- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to any mechanical cleansing vehicle.
- This Order shall come into operation on the 31st day of July, 1989 and may be cited as the West Glamorgan County Council (Link Roads, Cimla Road/Moorlands Road, Cimla, Neath) (One Way) Order 1989.
