WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

(LLEWELLYN ROAD CAR PARK ACCESS ROAD, PORT TALBOT)

(ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1982

The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 (1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part 1X of the Transport Act, 1968, and Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972, and Section 1 and Schedule 7 to the Local Government Planning and Land Act 1980 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

- No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in Llewellyn Road Car Park Access Road, Port Talbot from its junction with the M.4 Slip Road for a distance of approximately 40 metres other than in a south westerly direction.
- 2. The Interpretation Act, 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 3. This Order shall come into operation on the 28th day of January, 1982 and may be cited as the "West Glamorgan County Council (Llewellyn Road Car Park Access Road, Port Talbot) (One-Way Traffic) Order, 1982.
