WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

(NEW ROAD, CHRISTOPHER ROAD AND

BETHLEHEM ROAD, SKEWEN)

(PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND LIMITED WAITING)

AND (REVOCATION) ORDER 1987

The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of its powers as contained in Sections 1 and 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the said Act of 1934 hereby make the following Order.

- This Order may be cited as the West Glamorgan County Council (New Road, Christopher Road and Bethlehem Road, Skewen) (Prohibition of Waiting and Limited Waiting) and (Revocation) Order 1987 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of October 1987.
- The provisions of the following Orders are hereby revoked in so far as they relate to the sides or lengths of road set out in Schedule 1 to this Order:
 - i) The Trunk Road (New Road, Skewen, Neath Abbey Road, Neath; and Cadoxton Road, Neath) (Bus Stops) (Clearway) Order 1974, and
 - ii) The West Glamorgan County Council (New Road, Skewen) (Bus Stops Clearway) Order 1977, and
 - iii) West Glamorgan County Council (New Road, Skewen) (Prohibition and Limited Waiting) Order 1978
- 3. (1) In this Order:-

"disabled person's vehicle has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment) Regulations, 1975;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975;

"parking disc" means a disc, issued by a Local Authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS. No. 4631: 1970) coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins; and

"relevant position" means -

- (i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited thereon with the observe side facing forwards on the nearside of and immediately behind the windscreen.
- (ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or nearside of the vehicle.
- (2) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 4. Save as provided in Articles 5 and 6 of this Order no person shall cause any vehicle to wait at any time between 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day except Sunday on the sides or lengths of road set out in the Second Schedule to this Order or to wait for longer than one hour, return prohibited within one hour on any day except Sunday on the sides or lengths of roads set out in the Third Schedule to this Order.
- Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the lengths or sides of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
 - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle
 - (b) good to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle
 - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used in any other road for such purpose to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the side of road or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said sides or lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any

telecommunication apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984, or

- d) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local—authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
- e) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivery or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953.
- f) the vehicle to take in petrol water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said sides or lengths of road.
- g) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used in any other road to be used in connection with any wedding or funeral.
- h) to a public service vehicle when stopping at an authorised bus stop to set down or pick up passengers.
- 6. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc on which the person on charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on the sides of roads referred to in the said Article for a period not exceeding 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side or sides of road).
- 7. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

SCHEDULE 1 - REVOCATION OF ORDERS

(i) Clearway Order - New Road (north side)No Stopping 7 a.m. - 7 p.m. except for buses

From a point 30 metres from the eastern kerbline of Picton Road for a distance of 35 metres approximately in an easterly direction.

(ii) 1 Hour Limited Waiting Mon - Sat 8 a.m. - 6 p.m.

From a point 92 metres from the eastern kerb line of Picton Road for a distance of 18 metres approximately in an easterly direction.

(iii) New Road (south side)
 No Waiting Mon - Sat 8 a.m. = 6 p.m.

From a point 10 metres from the western kerb line of High Street for a distance of 25 metres approximately in a westerly direction.

SCHEDULE 2

(i) Prohibition of Waiting Monday - Saturday 8 a.m. - 6 p.m.

a. New Road (north side)

From the western kerb line of Station Road for a distance of 30 metres in a westerly direction.

From the eastern kerb line of Station Road for a distance of 5 metres in an easterly direction.

From the western kerb line of Grove Lane for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction.

From the eastern kerb line of Grove Lane for a distance of 5 metres in an easterly direction.

From the western kernb line of Picton Road for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction.

From the eastern kerb line of Picton Road for a distance of 60 metres in an easterly direction.

b. New Road (south side)

From the eastern kerb line of High Street for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction.

From the western kerb line of High Street for a distance of 20 metres in a westerly direction.

c. Christopher Road (both sides)

From the southern kerb line of New Road for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction.

SCHEDULE 3

1 Hour Limited Waiting Monday - Saturday 8 a.m. - 6 p.m.

a. New Road (north side)

From a point 5 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Station Road to a point 5 metres of the western kerb line of Grove Road.

From a point 5 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Grove Road to a point 5 metres west of the western kerb line of Picton Road.

From a point 60 metres from the eastern kerb line of Picton Road for a distance of 30 metres in an easterly direction.

b. New Road (south side)

From a point 20 metres west of the western kerb line of High Street for a distance of 15 metres in a westerly direction.

c. Bethlehem Road (north east side)

From a point 15 metres south east of the southern kerb line of New Road for a distance of 60 metres in a south easterly direction.
