(NEW STREET, GLYNNEATH)

(PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING)

ORDER, 1976

The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 (1); (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act, 1974, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C (1) of the said Act of 1967 as amended hereby make the following Order -

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait, be loaded or unloaded between the hours of 8.30 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and also 3.00 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. Monday to Friday inclusive on any of the sides of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait on any of the sides of road referred to in that Article, for so long as may be necessary, if the vehicle is a School Bus under Contract to the West Glamorgan County Council, for the conveyance of school children.
- 3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended as aforesaid, or by or under any other enactment.
- 4. The Interpretation Act, 1889, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- 5. This Order shall come into operation on the 21st. day of , 1976 and may be cited as the "West Glamorgan County Council (New Road, Glynneath) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order, 1976".

SCHEDULE

NEW STREET (NORTH SIDE)

From the eastern end of the lower entrance markings eastwards to the western end of the top entrance markings, a distance of approximately 26 metres.

NEW STREET (SOUTH SIDE)

From the western boundary of Cwm Nedd Junior School eastwards to the western end of the entrance marking, a distance of approximately 36 metres.
