ORDER 2003

THE NEATH PORT TALBOT COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "The Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

1. The Order shall come into operation on the 14th day of July 2003 and may be cited as the "Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Margam Bus Route) (No Stopping At Any Time Except Buses) Order 2003"
2. (1) In this Order –
 - "Bus" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to carry more than 8 passengers (exclusive of the driver) and Public Service Vehicles not so constructed or adapted used for the provision of local services;
 - "Public Services Vehicle" shall have the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981 and "local service" shall have the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Transport Act 1985;
 - "Universal Service Providers" means those operators of postal services who are licensed to provide all or part of a Universal Postal Service under the provisions contained in the Postal Services Act 2000.
- (2) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- (3) The Interpretation Act 1977 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. (1) The provisions contained in Article 4 of the West Glamorgan County Council (Taibach – Margam) (Area Traffic Management) Order 1994 are hereby revoked insofar as they relate to the lengths of sides of roads set out in Schedule 1 of this Order.

- (2) The provisions contained in Article 3 of the West Glamorgan County Council (Talbot Road, Port Talbot) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1977 are hereby revoked insofar as they relate to the following length of side of road:

Talbot Road, Port Talbot
South West Side

Between points approximately 90 metres and 117 metres south east of its junction with Oakwood Road

- (3) The provisions contained in any existing Road Traffic Regulation Orders relating to the following length of side of road are hereby revoked insofar as they relate to that length of side of road:

Talbot Road, Port Talbot
North East Side

Between points approximately 2 metres and 27 metres south east of its junction with Eagle Street.

4. Save as provided in Articles 5 and 6 of this order no vehicle shall stop at any time on the sides and lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order other than a bus:
5. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the lengths of sides or roads specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
- (A) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations namely:-
- (i) Building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) The removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) The laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths of sides or road of any sewer or any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (B) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a Local Authority or a Water Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

- (C) The vehicle to be used by a Universal Service Provider for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets;
6. The prohibitions imposed by Article 4 of this Order shall not apply to Police, Fire, Ambulance or other Emergency Service vehicles or to Local Authority vehicles when in pursuance of statutory duties or powers.

SCHEDULES

Schedule 1 – Revocations

Margam Road, Margam

North West Side

Between points approximately 1 metre and 12 metres east of its junction with Heol-Yr-Orsedd

South West Side

Between points approximately 1 metre and 13 metres north west of its junction with Phoenix Avenue

North East Side

Between points approximately 3 metres and 15 metres south east of its junction with Earl Road.

East Side

Between points approximately 4 metres and 13 metres south east of its junction with Tyfry Road.

Schedule 2 – No Stopping At Any Time Except Buses

1. **Talbot Road, Port Talbot**
North East Side

Between points approximately 2 metres and 27 metres south east of its junction with Eagle Street.

South West Side

- (1) Between points approximately 90 metres and 117 metres south east of its junction with Oakwood Road.

North East Side

Between points approximately 3 metres and 23 metres south east of its junction with Earl Road.

East Side

Between points approximately 20 metres and 40 metres south east of its junction with Twll yn y Wal Road.

West Side

Between points approximately 52 metres and 71 metres south east of its junction with Graig Avenue.

East Side

Between points approximately 4 metres and 24 metres south east of its junction with Tyfry Road.

West Side

From its south western kerbline from a point approximately 15 metres south west of the Beechwood Road junction western edge kerbline for a distance of 20 metres in a south easterly direction.

South Side

Between points approximately 60 metres and 104 metres north west of its junction with Margam Road/Tollgate Road.

North Side

Between points approximately 338 metres and 370 metres south east of its junction with Beechwood Road (opposite nos. 67-73 Beechwood Road)
