WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

(PARK AVENUE, HIGH STREET AND HEOL Y GLYN, GLYNNEATH)

(REVOCATION, PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND

UNLOADING) ORDER 1981

The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) (2) (3) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974 and Schedule 7 of the Local Government Planning and Land Act 1980 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1967") and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84(C)1 of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on the ^{31st} day of **AUGUST** 1981 and may be cited as the "West Glamorgan County Council (Park Avenue, High Street, and Heol y Glyn, Glynneath) (Revocation, Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1981".

2. (1) In this Order -

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) (Amendment Regulations 1975;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1975;

"parking disc" means a disc issued by a local authority, complying with the requirements of the British Standard Specification for Parking Discs (BS. No. 4631 : 1970), coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins; and

"relevant position" means -

(i) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen the badge is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the nearside of and immediately behind the windscreen;

(ii) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the front or nearside of the vehicle.

(2) The Interpretation Act, 1978, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

3. The undermentioned Orders are hereby revoked insofar as they relate to any of the sides or lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1, 2 and 3 to this Order:-

(i) The Glamorgan County Council (Various Streets, Glynneath) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1968

- (ii) West Glamorgan County Council (Various Streets, Glynneath) (Revocation and Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 1975
 - (iii) the Trunk Road (Various Roads, Glynneath (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1968
 - (iv) the Trunk Road (High Street, Glynneath (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1968
4. Save as provided in Articles 7, 8 and 9 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of a Police constable in uniform, or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time or load goods onto or unload goods from any vehicle on the sides or lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
5. Save as provided in Articles 7, 8 and 9 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00a.m. and 6.00 p.m. from Monday to Saturday (inclusive) on the sides or lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
6. Save as provided in Articles 7 and 8 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to be loaded or unloaded on the sides or lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
7. Nothing in Articles 4, 5 and 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on lengths of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-
- (i) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (ii) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:-
 - (a) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (b) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (c) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the side or road; or
 - (d) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said side of road or any sewer or of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1978; or
 - (iii) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (iv) the vehicle to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as

defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act, 1953.

8. Nothing in Article 5 of this Order shall render it unlawful for goods to be loaded or unloaded from a vehicle, waiting on the sides or lengths or road specified therein.
9. Nothing in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on the side of road referred to in the said Article for a period not exceeding 2 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of road).
10. The prohibition and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1967 or by or under any other enactment.

SCHEDULE 1

PROHIBITION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING

HIGH STREET, GLYNNEATH - SOUTH SIDE

- i) From a point in line with the eastern edge of Bethel Road, Glynneath to the end of the Clearway Order on the A4109 dual carriageway a distance of 120 metres or thereabouts
- ii) From the commencement of the Clearway Order on the A4109 dual carriageway to a point 260 metres or thereabouts in an easterly direction

HIGH STREET, GLYNNEATH - NORTH SIDE

- iii) From a point in line with the western kerb line of Heol y Glyn to a point 58 metres or thereabouts in a westerly direction
- iv) From a point in line with the eastern kerb line of Heol y Glyn to a point 58 metres or thereabouts in an easterly direction.

SCHEDULE 2

PROHIBITION OF WAITING 8.00 a.m. - 6.00 p.m.

MONDAY TO SATURDAY (INCLUSIVE)

HIGH STREET (SOUTH SIDE) PARK AVENUE (SOUTH SIDE) (PART OF)

- i) From a point in line with the western edge of Bethel Road for a distance of 52 metres or thereabouts in a westerly direction to the eastern end of the lay by outside the Glynneath Social Club.
- ii) From the western end of the lay by outside the Glynneath Social Club for a distance of 412 metres or thereabouts in a western direction to a point approximately 98 metres or thereabouts west of the western kerb line of Gelli Dawel Road.

SCHEDULE 3

PROHIBITION OF LOADING AND UNLOADING

i) HEOL Y GLYN (WESTERN SIDE)

From a point in line with the northern kerb line of High Street to a point 60 metres or thereabouts in a northerly direction.

ii) HEOL Y GLYN (EASTERN SIDE)

From a point in line with the northern kerb line of High Street to a point 52 metres or thereabouts in a northerly direction.
