

THE WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS)

PONTARDAWE, ONE-WAY TRAFFIC, ORDER 1982.

The Council of the County of West Glamorgan (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 and Section 1 and Schedule 7 to the Local Government Planning and Land Act 1980 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C (1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order :-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the *26th April* 1982 and may be cited as the West Glamorgan County Council (Various Roads) (Pontardawe) (One-Way Traffic) Order 1982.
2. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the road or in any of the lengths of road specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that road or length of road in column 2 of that Schedule.

1. That length of Herbert Street which extends from its junction with Holly Street to its junction with High Street, a distance of 194 metres or thereabouts.	From East to West
2. That length of Tawe Terrace Herbert Street Link Road which extends from its junction with Tawe Terrace to its junction with Herbert Street, a distance of 80 metres or thereabouts.	From North to South
