

NEATH PORT TALBOT COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL

(PONTRHYDYFEN)

(AREA TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT)

ORDER 1997

The Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (as successors to West Glamorgan County Council) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 and 2 and 84 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 10th day of February 1997 and may be cited as the "West Glamorgan County Council (Pontrhydyfen) (Area Traffic Management) Order 1997".
2. (i) Save as provided in Article 2(ii) of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle the weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes to be driven in that length of road as set out in Schedule 1 to this Order.  
 (ii) The prohibitions imposed by Article 2(i) to this Order shall not apply to:-
  - a) police, fire service, ambulance, emergency service or public service vehicles operating a local service.
  - b) Local Authority vehicles in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
  - c) any vehicle requiring access to premises in or on the said length of road.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 m.p.h. in the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
4. Save as provided in Article 5 to this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in that direction in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 3 to this Order if there is a vehicle proceeding or waiting to proceed in the opposite direction in those lengths of road specified.
5. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes.
6. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

Schedule 1

7.5 tonne weight Restriction (Except for Access) Order  
B4287

From a point in line with the south east kerbline of Tonmawr Road to a point in line with the northern kerbline of Glan Pelenna, a distance of approximately 125 metres.

Schedule 2

30 m.p.h. Speed Restriction Order  
B4287

Extension of an existing Order.

From a point approximately 100 metres north west of the junction with Tonmawr Road for a distance of approximately 150 metres in a north westerly direction.

Schedule 3

Traffic Priority in One Direction Order, Northbound  
B4287

At a point approximately 35 metres south east of the junction with Tonmawr Road.

Traffic Priority in One Direction Order -- Southbound

At a point approximately 210 metres south east of the junction with Tonmawr Road.
