ORDER 1978

The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1 (1), (2), (3) (6) and 84D (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 6 to the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which Act of 1967 as amended is hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C (1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the ¹⁸ day of ~~SEPTEMBER~~ 1978 and may be cited as the "West Glamorgan County Council (Port Talbot Inner By-Pass) (24 Hour Main Carriageway Clearway) Order 1976 (Amendment No.1) Order 1978".
2. The following Orders made by the former Port Talbot Borough Council on the dates indicated are hereby revoked insofar as they relate to the length of road referred to in the Schedule to this Order:-

 "The Council of the Borough of Port Talbot (Water Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1978" - 31 July 1958.

 "The Council of the Borough of Port Talbot (Prohibition of Waiting) (Water Street) Amendment Order 1966" - 22 August 1966.
3. The "West Glamorgan County Council (Port Talbot Inner By-Pass) (24 Hour Main Carriageway Clearway) Order 1976 made by the West Glamorgan County Council on the 8 day of June 1976 and hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order, is amended by the addition of the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order to the Schedule to the Principal Order.
4. The Interpretation Act 1889 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
