

The Council of the Borough of Fort Tallot in exercise of their powers under Sub Sections (1), (2), and (3), of Section 26 and Sub Section (4) of Section 27 of the Road Traffic Act, 1960, and of all other powers then enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order :-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on either side of that part of Parry Road from the junction of Strauss Road to Silver Avenue a distance of 450 feet.

2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall prevent any person from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in the length of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary :-

- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle ;
- (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle ; or
- (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently

be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the length of road so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or near to the said length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act, 1878; or

- (d) to enable the vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said length of road.

- (e) to allow vehicles to park in the layby fronting the

30 minutes in any hour.

3. Nothing in this Order shall apply to any vehicle owned by a funeral director or owner of funeral vehicles when in use as part of a funeral cortege or otherwise in connection with a funeral.
4. The Interpretation Act, 1909, shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
5. This Order shall come into operation on the 19th day of September 1966 and may be cited as "the Council of the Borough of Port Talbot" (Prohibition of Waiting) (Parry Road Shopping Centre Sandfields) Order 1966.
