- 2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall prevent any perso from causing or permitting a vehicle to wait in the length of road referred to in that Article for so long as may be necessary:-
  - (a) to enable a person to board or slight from the vehicle;
  - (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle; or
  - (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently

- This Order shall come into operation on the 19th day of September 5. 1966 and may be cited as "the Council of the Borough of Port Talbot" (Frohibition of Maiting) ( Parry Road Shopping Centre Sandfields) Order 1966.
