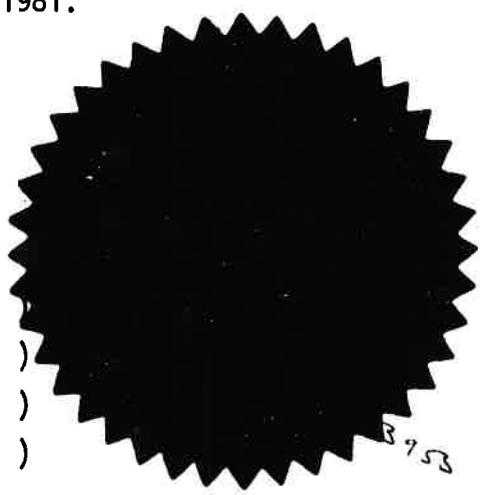
(STANDERT TERRACE, REAR LANE, SEVEN SISTERS)

(ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER, 1981

The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967 as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968 Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act 1972 and Schedule 7 to the Local Government Planning and Land Act 1980 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C (1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order :

1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in Standert Terrace, Rear Lane, Seven Sisters between its junction with the A4109 and Bryn Bedd except in a southerly direction.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply to any mechanical road cleansing vehicle.
3. This Order shall come into operation on the <sup>1st</sup> day of FEBRUARY 1981 and may be cited as the "West Glamorgan County Council (Standert Terrace, Rear Lane, Seven Sisters) (One-Way Traffic) Order, 1981.
