## CTU COMMOIL OF THE RESCHOREST PORTION OF THE COMMON OF THE

The Port Talbot Borough Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), (2) and (3) and section 2(4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 and of all powers them \* enabling in that behalf hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. Save as provided in Article 2 of this Order no particle shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform. cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00.a.m. and 6.00.p.m. in the road known as Lane leading to Margam Terrace from Station Road (opposite Courtland Place).
- (a) From the junction of Station Road, east side frontage of 43 Station Road, in a South Westerly direction to the East side frontage of 45 Margam Terrace, being a distance of 250 feet, and
- (b) From the junction of Station Road, west side frontage of 41 Station Road in a South Mesterly direction to a point opposite the east side frontage of 45 Margam Terrace, being a distance of 250 feet.
- Nothing in Article 1, of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the road, on the side of road or in any of the lengths of road referred to in that Article, as the case may be, for so long as may be necessary:-
- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle:
- (b) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle.
- to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the road, the side of road or the length of read so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said road, the said side of road or the said side of road or the said length of road of any sewer or of any main pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or


and the purpose in any other read, to be used in

to enhale the vehicle to take in retrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said road, the said side of road or the said length of road.

- The restrictions imposed by Article 1 or Article 2 of this Orlan, as the case may be, shall not apply to the following vehicles, that is to say:-
- vehicles while waiting upon a duly authorised parking place; or
- (b) nackney carriages while waiting at a duly authorised cab rank; or
- funeral vehicle owned by a funeral director or owner of funeral vehicles when in use as part of a funeral cortege or otherwise in connection with a funeral
- The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect to if made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967 or by or under any other enactment.
