THE A465 TRUNK ROAD (ABERDULAIS-LLANDARCY, WEST GLAMORGAN)
(PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS) ORDER 1994

MADE

LOTH MARCH 1994

COMING INTO FORCE 21ST MARCH 1994 .

The Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (3) and 124 of and paragraph 27 of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police for the South Wales Police, hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into force on the 21st March 1994 and may be cited as the A465 Trunk Road (Aberdulais-Llandarcy, West Glamorgan) (Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 1994.
- 2. In this Order:-

"the trunk road" means that length of the trunk road described in the Schedule to this Order and includes every part of that road, in particular any slip road, unless expressly excluded;

"slip road" means any road that either leads from a main carriageway of the trunk road onto or off a roundabout or interchange or onto or off a main carriageway of another road;

"lay-by" means any area of the trunk road intended for the waiting of vehicles lying at a side of the trunk road bounded either wholly or partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 of Schedule 2 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981(b); and

"footway" has the meaning given in section 329 of the Highways Act 1980(c).

3. Save as provided in article 4 of this Order no pedestrian shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, proceed in the trunk road, excluding any lay-by or the footway at Aberdulais Interchange in the County of West Glamorgan on the northern side of the trunk road which extends from a point approximately 126 metres north east of Penscynor Railway Bridge in a south easterly direction for a distance of approximately 49 metres.

- 4. Nothing in article 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful for a pedestrian to proceed in the trunk road where:
 - a. it is necessary for him to do so to avoid or prevent an accident or to obtain or give help required as the result of an accident or emergency, and he does so in such a manner as to cause as little danger or inconvenience as possible to other traffic on the trunk road;
 - b. he does so in the exercise of his duty as a police constable or as a member of a fire brigade or of an ambulance service;
 - c. it is necessary for him to do so as a result of a vehicle stopping on the trunk road by reason of a breakdown or other defect or by reason of its being prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside the control of the driver;
 - d. it is necessary for him to do so in order to recover or move any object which has fallen onto the trunk road;
 - e. it is necessary for him to do so in order to carry out in an efficient manner
 - i. the maintenance, repair, cleaning, clearance, alteration, or improvement of any part of the trunk road; or
 - ii. the removal of any vehicle from any part of the trunk road; or
 - iii. the erection, laying, placing, maintenance, testing, alteration, repair or removal of any structure, works or apparatus in, on, under, over or abutting any part of the trunk road:
 - f. it is necessary for him to do so in connection with any inspection, survey, investigation, or census which relates to the trunk road or any part thereof and which is carried out in accordance with any general or special authority granted by the Secretary of State;
- 5. The Trunk Road (Aberdulais-Llandarcy, West Glamorgan) (Prohibition of Foot Passengers) Order 1975(a) is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

That length of the Neath-Abergavenny Trunk Road (A465) between Aberdulais and Llandarcy in the County of West Glamorgan which extends from, and including Aberdulais Interchange to, but excluding, Llandarcy Interchange.
