

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

THE CONVERSION OF HIGHWAYS INTO FOOTPATHS OR BRIDLEWAYS (MELYN CLOSE, NEATH) ORDER 1983

MADE

The Secretary of State for Wales makes this Order in exercise of his powers under section 212 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, and of all other enabling powers:-

- 1. Any right which persons may have to use vehicles on the highway described in Schedule 1 to this Order and shown edged black on the deposited plan is hereby extinguished.
- 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 1 of this Order, the said highway may be used by vehicles in the cases specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 3. In this Order "the deposited plan" means the plan numbered "WOC/212-74", marked "Highways at Neath, in the County of West Glamorgan", signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Welsh Office, Curran Embankment Repository, Curran Embankment, Cardiff.
- 4. This Order shall come into operation on the date on which notice that it has been made is first published in accordance with section 215(7) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and may be cited as the Conversion of Highways into Footpaths or Bridleways (Melyn Close, Neath) Order 1983.

SCHEDULE 1

The highway to which this Order relates is at Neath in the County of West Glamorgan. It is shown by a solid black line on the deposited plan and is that length of road known as Melyn Close which extends from its junction with Furnace Terrace in a southerly direction for a distance of 63.8 yards.

SCHEDULE 2

Cases where vehicles are permitted to use the highway described in Schedule 1 to this Order -

- 1. Where the vehicle is a vehicle of any description and is using the highway
 - a. for Police, Ambulance or Fire Brigade purposes;
 - b. in accordance with a special authorisation for that use given by or on behalf of the West Glamorgan County Council, the Neath Borough Council or the Chief Officer of Police for that area;
 - c. on behalf of a statutory undertaker, a water authority or the Post Office engaged upon the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal of any sewer, sewage disposal work, land drainage work, watercourse or of any main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878 under, in, on, over, along or across the highway or any land adjacent to the highway;
 - d. for the purpose of gaining access to the rear entrance of 15 Furnace Terrace, Melyn. Neath.
