THE NEATH - ABERGAVENNY TRUNK ROAD (GLYN NEATH BY-PASS) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) (CLEARWAYS) (WALES) ORDER 1974

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Secretary of State for Wales intends to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act 1968, the effect of which will be to prohibit (with certain exceptions) the waiting of vehicles in any part of the carriageways forming part of the length of trunk road specified in the Schedule hereto. The prohibition will not apply to stage carriages or express carriager.

The Order will also prohibit trading from the verges of the main carriageways of that length of road.

Copies of the proposed Order, together with a plan and a statement of reasons for making the Order, are available for inspection during normal office hours at the offices of the Divisional Surveyor, Mid Glamorgan County Council, Highways Depot, Hirwaun Industrial Estate, Hirwaun, Aberdare, Mid Glamorgan.

Objections to the proposed Order should be sent to the Secretary, Welsh Office, Roads Division (Y Swyddfa Gymreig, Adran Ffyrdd), Graham Buildings, 139 Newport Road, Cardiff, by 26 SEP 1974 quoting the reference number quoting the reference number WR 15/5/3 and stating the grounds of objection.

SECTION OF THE NEATH - ABERGAVENNY TRUNK ROAD (A465)
