

**NEATH PORT TALBOT COUNTY BOROUGH COUNCIL
(THORNEY ROAD, BAGLAN, PORT TALBOT)
(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
ORDER 1997**


The Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council in exercise of its powers as contained in Sections 1 and 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1984") and of all other powers then enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come in to operation on the 11th day of June 1997 and may be cited as the "Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Thorney Road, Baglan, Port Talbot)(Prohibition of Driving) Order 1997".
2. ~~The~~ Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven in those sections of roads specified in the Schedules.
4. The prohibition imposed by this order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any other prohibition or restriction whether made under the Act of 1984 or otherwise.

SCHEDULES

- (i) Thorney Road, Baglan
Between points 92 and 97 metres west of its junction with Eider Road.
- (ii) Maple Road, Baglan
Between points 210 and 215 metres south of its junction with Thorney Road.
