ORDER 2005

The Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1, 2 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 18th day of July 2005 and may be cited as the "Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Various Schools in Neath Port Talbot) (Traffic Management) Order 2005.
- 2. (1) In this Order –

"Public Services Vehicle" shall have the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981 and "local service" shall have the same meaning as in Section 1 of the Transport Act 1985;

"Universal Service Providers" means those operators of postal services who are licensed to provide all or part of a Universal Postal Service under the provisions contained in the Postal Services Act 2000.

- (2) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- (3) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

- 3. The provisions of the Order specified in Schedule 1 of this Order are hereby revoked insofar as they relate to the length of side of road specified in that Schedule.
- 4. Save as provided in Articles 8 and 9 of this Order, no person except on the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or a Parking Attendant shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait, load or unload at anytime on the lengths of sides of roads set out in Schedule 2 of this Order.
- 5. Save as provided in Articles 9 and 10 of this Order no vehicle shall stop at any time on Monday to Fridays on the lengths of sides of road set out in Schedule 3 of this Order.
- 6. Save as provided in Articles 9 and 10 of this Order no vehicle shall stop between the hours of 8.30 a.m. to 9.30 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m. on Monday to Fridays on the lengths of sides of road set out in Schedule 4 of this Order.
- 7. Save as provided in Articles 9 and 10 of this Order no vehicle shall stop between the hours of 8.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. on Monday to Fridays on the lengths of sides of roads set out in Schedule 5 of this Order.
- 8. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the lengths of sides of roads specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable: -
 - (A) A person to board or alight from a vehicle;
 - (B) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations namely: -
 - (i) Building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) The removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) The laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths of sides of road of any sewer or any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (C) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a Local Authority or a Water Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (D) The vehicle to be used by a Universal Service Provider for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets;
- (E) Public Services Vehicles operating a local service when waiting at an authorised bus stop to set down or pick up passengers, or to school buses;
- (F) The vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said length of road.
- 9. The prohibitions imposed by Articles 4, 5, 6, 7 and 11 of this Order shall not apply to Police, Fire, Ambulance or other Emergency Service vehicles or to Local Authority vehicles when in pursuance of statutory duties or powers.
- 10. Nothing in Articles 5, 6, 7 and 11 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the lengths of sides of roads specified therein for so long as may be necessary to enable: -
 - (A) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations namely: -
 - (i) Building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) The removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) The laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths of sides of road of any sewer or any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or any telecommunications apparatus defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (B) The vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in the service of a Local Authority or a Water Authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

- (C) The vehicle to be used by a Universal Service Provider for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets;
- (D) Public Services Vehicles operating a local service when waiting at an authorised bus stop to set down or pick up passengers, or to school buses;
- (E) The vehicle to take in petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said length of road.
- 11. Save as provided in Articles 9 and 10 of this Order no vehicle shall stop between the hours of 8.00am to 4.00pm on Mondays to Fridays on the lengths of sides of roads set out in Schedule 6 of this Order.

Schedule 1 Revocations

1. Neath Port Talbot County Borough Council (Various School Entrances)
(Traffic Management) Order 2004

<u>Central Junior School – Broad Street, Port Talbot</u> West Side

Between points approximately 38 metres and 72 metres north of its junction with Talbot Road rear lane.

Schedule 2 No Waiting Loading or Unloading at Anytime

1. <u>Blaenbaglan Primary School</u>

Maes-Ty-Canol, Baglan

South Side

From its junction with Tyn-y-Twr for a distance of approximately 46 metres in a westerly direction.

- 2. Traethmelyn Primary School
 - i) Southdown View, Sandfields

South Side

From its junction with Border Road for a distance of approximately 20 metres in a westerly direction and 14 metres in an easterly direction.

ii) <u>Border Road, Sandfields – Both Sides</u>
From its junction with Southdown View for a distance of approximately 16 metres in a southerly direction.

North Side

Between points approximately 76 metres and 144 metres east of its junction with St. Helier Drive.

North Side

Between points approximately 110 metres and 178 metres east of its junction with Ascot Drive.

3. <u>Tywyn Primary School</u>

Channel View, Sandfields

South Side

Between points approximately 26 metres and 76 metres west of its junction with Sunnybank Road.

4. <u>Maesmarchog Primary School</u>

Main Road, Dyffryn Cellwen

South Side

Between points approximately 32 metres and 70 metres west of its junction with School Road.

5. Gwaun Cae Gurwen Primary School

New Road, Gwaun-Cae-Gurwen

North Side

From a point in line with the Western kerbline of Clwyd Road, between points approximately 6 metres and 41 metres, and 110 metres and 145 metres in a westerly direction.

6. Crynant Primary School

School Road, Crynant

West Side

Between points approximately 135 metres and 202 metres westerly of its junction with Main Road.

7. Pontardawe Welsh School

Alltacham Drive, Pontardawe

West Side

Between points approximately 170 metres and 200 metres north of its junction with Gwyrddgoed.
