

WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL  
(VARIOUS STREETS, NEATH) (PROHIBITION AND  
RESTRICTION OF WAITING, LOADING AND UNLOADING  
(AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER, 1977

The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 1(1), (2), (3) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1967, as amended by Part IX of the Transport Act, 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act, 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C(1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the ~~27~~ <sup>28</sup> day of ~~November~~, 1977 and may be cited as the "West Glamorgan County Council (Various Streets, Neath) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) (Amendment No. 3) Order, 1977".
2. "The West Glamorgan County Council (Various Streets, Neath) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order, 1976" made on the 17th March, 1976 and hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Order" is hereby amended as follows:-
  - (i) That length of Arthur Street on the south side from a point 10 metres from London Road to a point 25 metres from Eastland Road to be deleted from Schedule 5 of the Principal Order.
  - (ii) That length of Geoffrey Street on the south side from a point 10 metres from London Road to a point 12 metres from Eastland Road to be deleted from Schedule 5 of the Principal Order.
  - (iii) That length of Forster Road on the north side from a point 10 metres from Groll Park Road and for a distance of 55 metres in an easterly direction to be deleted from Schedule 3 of the Principal Order and inserted into a New Schedule, Schedule 7, Prohibition of Waiting Monday to Friday 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. to be added to the Principal Order.
3. The Interpretation Act, 1889 shall apply for interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
