ORDER, 1976 (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 1979

The West Glamorgan County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1 (1), (2), (3) and 84D(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967, as amended by Part 1X of the Transport Act 1968, Schedule 19 to the Local Government Act, 1972 and Schedule 6 of the Road Traffic Act 1974 (which said Act of 1967 as so amended is hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1967") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Section 84C (1) of the Act of 1967, hereby make the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into operation on the ~~17~~ day of ~~DECEMBER~~, 1979 and may be cited as the "West Glamorgan County Council (Wern Road and Commercial Street, Ystalyfera (Prohibition and Limitation of Waiting and Doctors Parking Places) Order 1976 (Amendment No. 2) Order, 1979".
2. The West Glamorgan County Council (Wern Road and Commercial Street, Ystalyfera) (Prohibition and Limitation of Waiting and Doctors Parking Places) Order, 1976 made by the West Glamorgan County Council on the 9 day of January, 1976 and hereinafter referred to as the Principal Order is hereby amended by the deletion of the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order from the first Schedule to the Principal Order and its addition to the Second Schedule of the Principal Order.

SCHEDULE

Commercial Street (South Side)

From a point 22 metres east of the east side of Darren Road eastwards for a distance of approximately 12 metres.
