### THE HERTFORDSHIRE (WYMONDLEY ROAD, WYMONDLEY CLOSE, SORREL GARTH AND THE CHILTERNS, HITCHIN) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2020

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (Wymondley Road, Wymondley Close, Sorrel Garth and The Chilterns, Hitchin) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 2020" and shall come into effect on Friday 28 May 2021.
- 2. Save as provided in Articles 4, 5 and 6 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in those lengths of Wymondley Road, Wymondley Close, Sorrel Garth and The Chilterns, Hitchin as specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- 3. Save as provided in Articles 4, 5 and 6 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday inclusive in those lengths of Wymondley Road, Hitchin as specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- 4. (1) Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by those Articles (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") in relation to
  - (a) a vehicle being used for Fire and Rescue, Ambulance or Police purposes.
  - (b) anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a Police Constable in uniform; or with permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer as defined by the Traffic Management Act 2004 and appointed by North Hertfordshire District Council.
  - (c) a vehicle which is prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond the drivers control or which has stopped in order to avoid injury or damage to persons or property or when required to do so by law;
  - (d) a vehicle which is stationary in order that it may be used for one or more of the purposes specified in sub-Article (2) of this Article and which cannot reasonably be used for such a purpose without stopping in the restricted area;
  - (e) a marked vehicle which, whilst used by a universal service provider in the course of the provision of a universal postal service, is stationary only for so long as may be reasonably necessary for postal packets to be delivered or collected;

In this Article -

The expressions "universal service provider", "provision of a universal postal Service" and "postal packet" shall bear the same meanings as in Section 65 of the Postal Services Act 2011.

- (2) The "purposes" referred to in sub-Article (1)(d) of this Article are -
  - (a) any operation involving building, demolition or excavation;
  - (b) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
  - (c) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of a road;
  - (d) constructing, improving, maintaining, or cleaning of any street furniture; or
  - (e) the laying, erection, alteration, repair or cleaning of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus kept or installed for the purposes of a telecommunications code system or of any other telecommunications apparatus lawfully kept installed in any position.
- 5. Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order applies to the lengths of road restricted by those Articles (which said lengths of road are referred to in this Article as "the restricted area") so as to render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait only for so long as may be reasonably necessary –

- (a) to enable goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle from or to premises adjacent to the restricted area; or
- (b) to enable a passenger to board or alight and to load and unload any luggage.
- 6. (1) Nothing in Articles 2 and 3 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge and a parking disc, to wait at any time in the lengths of road specified in the Schedules of this Order for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same length of road).
  - (2) In this Article -

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 142(1) of the Act of 1984;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 3(1) of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000

"parking disc" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 8(5) of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000; and

"relevant position" has the same meaning as given in Regulation 4 of The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000

- 7. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
- The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.

## STATEMENT OF REASONS

# THE HERTFORDSHIRE (WYMONDLEY ROAD, WYMONDLEY CLOSE, SORREL GARTH AND THE CHILTERNS, HITCHIN) (RESTRICTION OF WAITING) ORDER 2020

The Hertfordshire County Council is proposing to introduce waiting restrictions in parts of Hitchin.

The proposals include:

- 'No waiting at any time' restrictions on parts of Wymondley Road, Wymondley Close, Sorrel Garth and The Chilterns.
- 'No waiting '8.00am to 6.00pm Monday to Saturday inclusive' restrictions on parts of Wymondley Road.

Implementation of a combination of no waiting at any time and limited waiting have been requested and supported by the Local Member. The objectives of the scheme are to improve road safety, by addressing inappropriate and obstructive parking. The likely impact on parking, as a result of the proposed restrictions, has been taken into consideration and balanced against the need to improve road safety and maintain a free flow of vehicular traffic.

Situated near the town centre, there's a sixth form nearby where there is a visibility issue as a junction is situated new the brow pf a hill and vehicles are being parked near the school and along the road by commuters wanting access to the town centre which is increasing the risk of an accident due to limited visibility for vehicles. The local member, with the support from the local borough and resident have asked for measures to be put in place to improve safety for highway users.

Access to properties is unaffected. The standard exemptions to DYL's will facilitate any loading / deliveries to properties. Some reduction in on street parking will arise, this is considered necessary to achieve the scheme goals. Improvements for access relating to larger and commercial vehicles is anticipated as a result of the restrictions. It is considered that the proposals will assist in facilitating the movement of such vehicles on the affected roads.


Therefore, it appears to the Highway Authority, having also considered the duty imposed by Section 122 Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, that it is necessary and expedient to make an Order in the interests of avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or any other road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising and for facilitating the passage on the road or any other road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians.

The proposal has been subject to consultation with local and County Councillors representing the area and North Herts District Council. The local Police, Ambulance, Fire and Rescue Services, Hertfordshire County Council Passenger Transport Unit and local residents have also been consulted.

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
