# (PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND STREET PARKING PLACES)

(CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AND CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2010 (FRANCES STREET AND ALLANBY STREET AREA, SCUNTHORPE) (EXPERIMENTAL AMENDMENT) ORDER 2013

North Lincolnshire Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. The North Lincolnshire Borough Council (Various Streets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2010 shall be amended to the following extent:
  - The Map Area Codes specified in the First Schedule to this Order shall be (a) revoked and:
  - The Map Area Codes specified in the Second Schedule to this Order (b) shall be inserted.
- 2. This Order shall come into operation on the 25<sup>th</sup> January 2013 for a period of 18 months and may be cited as The North Lincolnshire Borough Council (Various Streets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2010 (Frances Street and Allanby Street Area, Scunthorpe) (Experimental Amendment) Order 2013
- 3. During the operation of this Order, the Service Director of Places shall be empowered to exercise the modification or suspension provisions set out in Section 10 of the Act of 1984.
