

THE NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (NORTH WALSHAM, VARIOUS ROADS)
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) CONSOLIDATION AND VARIATION ORDER 2011

The Norfolk County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) 2(1) to (3) and 3(2) and 122 and parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:

1. In this Order:-

"motor cycle" has the same meaning as in s185(1) of The Road Traffic Act 1988";

'public service vehicle' shall have the same meaning as in section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

"public passenger transport service" shall have the same meaning as in section 63(10)(a) of the Transport Act 1985"

2. Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall, except upon the direction of, or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any:-

- (a) motor vehicle to proceed along the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order;
- (b) motor cycle to proceed along the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing a motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in that Article if the vehicle being used:

- (a) is for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
- (b) is in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (c) is in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer, water, gas, or electricity apparatus or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (d) is for the provision of a universal postal service as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
- (e) requires access to private property or land situated adjacent to the length of Station Road or Farman Avenue specified in Schedule 1 to this Order;
- (f) is a public service vehicle being used in connection with a public passenger transport service along the lengths of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order;

4. Save as provided in Article 5 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction or, or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed along the U10313 Nelson Way at its junction with the C560 Mundesley Road.
5. Nothing in Article 4 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing a motor vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in that Article if the vehicle being used:
 - (a) is for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) is in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (c) is in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer, water, gas, or electricity apparatus or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984.
6. Save as provided in Articles 7 8 and 9, no person shall, except upon the direction of, or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed along the C557 Market Place from its junction with the C557 Market Street to its junction with the C558 Church Street on Thursday from 0630 hrs to 1700 hrs.
7. Nothing in Article 6 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing a vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in that Article if the vehicle being used:
 - (a) is for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) is in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (c) is in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer, water, gas, or electricity apparatus or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (d) as part of a funeral cortege.
8. Nothing in Article 6 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed along the length of Market Place specified in that Article if the vehicle exhibits in a conspicuous position on the front or nearside of the vehicle a valid driving permit issued by the Highway Authority.
9. Nothing in Article 6 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle which is constructed or modified to include a stall and which is authorised as a market stall to wait and sell goods.

10. Save as provided in Articles 11 and 12, no person shall, except upon the direction of or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed along the Market Place around the Market Cross from its junction with the C557 Market Street eastwards for a distance of 76 metres (to the eastern point of property No 39 Market Place).
11. Nothing in Article 10 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing a vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in that Article if the vehicle being used:
 - (a) is for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (b) is in the service of a local authority or water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (c) is in connection with the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of that length of road or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or adjacent to that length of road of any sewer, water, gas, or electricity apparatus or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
12. Nothing in Article 10 of this Order shall apply to any vehicle which is constructed or modified to include a stall and which is authorised as a market stall to wait and sell goods on Thursday from 0630 hrs to 1700 hrs.
13. This Order shall come into operation on the 7th day of November 2011 and may be cited as The Norfolk County Council (North Walsham, Various Roads)(Traffic Regulation) Consolidation and Variation Order 2011.
14. The following Orders will become revoked and consolidated into this Order on the date of commencement of this Order as follows:-

“The Norfolk County Council (North Walsham, Station Road)(Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 2002” – in its entirety;

“The County of Norfolk (Farman Avenue, North Walsham)(Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1980” – in its entirety;

“The Norfolk County Council (Nelson Way, North Walsham)(Prohibition of Driving) Order 1992” – in its entirety;

“The County of Norfolk (North Walsham)(Prohibition of Driving) Order 1970” – in its entirety;

“The Norfolk County Council (North Walsham, Market Place) (Pedestrianisation/Prohibition of Driving) Order 2001” – in its entirety;

“The Norfolk County Council (North Walsham, Market Place)(Prohibition of Driving) Order 2001” – in its entirety;

"The Norfolk County Council (North Walsham, Market Place)(Prohibition of Driving)(Pedestrianisation/Prohibition of Driving)(Street Parking Places)(Disabled Parking Places) and (Goods Vehicle Loading Bay) Variation Order 2010" – in its entirety.

15. Insofar as any provision of this Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
