

**KETTERING BOROUGH COUNCIL**  
**(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES)**  
**ORDER 2020**

Kettering Borough Council (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 35(1) and (3), 3(A), 35A, 35B and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended ("the 1984 Act") and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Constable of Northamptonshire Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act hereby makes the following Order:

**PART 1**  
**GENERAL**

**Commencement and Citation**

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of November 2020 and may be cited as Kettering Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2020.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Order, except where explicitly stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article shall be construed as a reference to the Article bearing that number in this Order. Any reference in this Order to a Part is a reference to a Part of this Order and any reference to a Schedule is a reference to a Schedule to this Order.
3. In this Order, except where the context requires otherwise, the words and expressions in Schedule 1 shall have the meanings assigned to them in that Schedule.
4. Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

5. Unless the context otherwise requires, words denoting the singular shall include the plural and vice versa. Words denoting persons shall include either gender, bodies corporate, unincorporated associations and partnerships.
6. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

## **PART 2**

### **DESIGNATION AND USE OF PARKING PLACES**

#### Designation

7. Each area of land or building named in Schedule 2 and as shown on the plans in Schedule 9 may be used as a place to park vehicles subject to the conditions set out in this Order.

#### On entering the parking place

8. On entering the parking place the driver must proceed without undue delay to park in a parking bay appropriate for their intended stay and must remain parked in that parking bay until the vehicle leaves the parking place.

#### Class of vehicle

9. Where a parking place in Schedule 2 or a parking bay in Schedule 6 is described as available only for vehicles of a specified class and this is signed at the parking place then no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be parked within that parking place or parking bay unless it is of the class specified.

#### Position of vehicle

10. If parking bays are marked-out in a parking place the driver of a vehicle shall ensure this it is not parked beyond the parking bay markings.

11. A vehicle will not be parked in contravention of this Order if the vehicle is parked within a parking place but beyond bay markings if a vehicle is continuously being used for an activity set out in Schedule 7.
12. Whether or not parking bays are marked out in a parking place the driver of a vehicle shall ensure that it is positioned so that it does not obstruct other vehicles using the parking place, the free flow of traffic circulating within the parking place or the entrances to and exits from the parking place.

#### Days and Hours of operation

13. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be parked in a parking place or parking bay outside the days and hours set out in Schedule 2 and Schedule 6 respectively and as signed at the parking place.

#### Maximum stay

14. Where in Schedules 3 and 4 or in Schedule 6 and as signed at the parking place a parking place or parking bay is described as being limited to a maximum period of stay, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be parked in that parking place or parking bay for any period longer than that specified.

#### The requirement to vacate

15. Where in Schedules 3 and 4 or in Schedule 6 and as signed at the parking place a parking place or parking bay is described as needing to be vacated by a specified time, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be parked in that parking place or parking bay after the time specified.

#### Period of no return

16. Where in Schedules 3 and 4 or in Schedule 6 and as signed at the parking place a parking place or parking bay is described as having a period within which a vehicle may not return, no person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be parked again in that parking place or parking bay

during the time for which the vehicle is excluded from being parked in the parking place or parking bay.

**Power to close or suspend parking places**

17. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Council by notice, sign or barrier displayed or erected in a parking place from closing a parking place or any part or parts thereof for any period.
18. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Council by notice, sign or barrier displayed or erected in a parking place from suspending the use of a parking place or any part or parts thereof on certain days or during certain parts of days to be set aside for use only by particular vehicles or organisations.
19. Any person closing or suspending the use of a parking place or any part thereof shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or that part thereof a notice or traffic sign indicating that the parking place or that part thereof is closed or the use is suspended and parking by vehicles is prohibited.
20. No person shall without the authority of the Council cause or permit a vehicle to be parked in a parking place or any part thereof during such periods that the parking place or that part thereof is closed or the use is suspended.

**Sale of Goods**

21. No person shall in a parking place without the express written permission of the Council use a vehicle in connection with the sale of any article, including the vehicle itself, to any person in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of skill or services in any other capacity.

Parked with engine running

22. No person shall in a parking place continue to run the engine when the vehicle is in the parking place and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.

**PART 3  
PAYMENT FOR PARKING**

The requirement to pay

23. Unless an exemption set out in Part 4 applies, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be parked in a parking place during the chargeable days and hours set out Schedules 3 and 4 without payment of the applicable parking charge as set out in those Schedules.
24. If at any time while a vehicle is parked in a parking place no pay-and-display ticket is displayed on that vehicle and no valid alternative payment method is in place in accordance with the provisions of this Order it shall be deemed that the parking charge has not been paid.

Pay-and-display payment

25. On parking the vehicle in a parking bay the driver of the vehicle shall without undue delay arrange for the purchase of a pay-and-display ticket from a ticket machine situated at that parking place for the period required in accordance with the charges specified in Schedules 3 and 4.
26. The driver of the vehicle shall ensure that a valid pay-and-display ticket is displayed in the relevant position in the vehicle in respect of which it was issued at all times the vehicle is parked.
27. A pay-and-display ticket is not transferable from one vehicle to another and on transfer the pay-and-display ticket ceases to be valid.

28. A pay-and-display ticket is valid only in the parking place in which it was issued. In all cases pay-and-display tickets shall only be valid for the period for which payment was made.
29. The expiry of the period for which the parking charge has been paid shall be when the time shown on the clock of the issuing ticket machine is later than the expiry time shown on the pay-and-display ticket displayed.

#### Alternative payment methods

30. The Council may make available one or more alternative payment methods which can be used instead of pay-and-display. These may be provided by the Council or through a third party and will be advertised in the parking place.
31. Payment by alternative payment method shall have equal validity to the purchase of a pay-and-display ticket providing all applicable conditions are met.
32. The parking charges set out in Schedules 3 and 4 are equally applicable for an alternative payment method but a provider may make additional charges for the services they provide.
33. Other than the requirement to purchase a pay-and-display ticket the driver of the vehicle must comply with all other provisions in this Order.

#### Ticket machine out-of-order

34. If when the vehicle is initially parked in a parking place the ticket machine nearest to the vehicle is out-of-order then a ticket shall be obtained from another ticket machine within the same parking place (where provided).
35. If when the vehicle is initially parked in a parking place there is no ticket machine at the parking place or all ticket machines at that parking

place are out-of-order the driver of the vehicle shall be exempt from purchasing a pay-and-display ticket but is required to adhere to all other requirements in this Order.

## **PART 4 EXEMPTIONS**

### **Disabled Person's Badge**

36. A vehicle parked in a disabled person's parking bay or general bay which displays in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge is exempt from the parking charge, provided that immediately before or after the act of parking the vehicle has been used or is about to be used by the person(s) in respect of whom the badge is issued.

### **Motorcycles**

37. A motorcycle parked in a motorcycle bay or general parking bay is exempt from the parking charge.

### **Police vehicles**

38. A police vehicle parked wholly within a police bay is exempt from the parking charge.

### **Electric vehicles**

39. An electric vehicle parked in an electric vehicle charging bay is exempt from the parking charge while charging the vehicle up to the maximum period of time as set out in Schedules 3 and 4 and as signed at the parking place.

### **Season tickets**

40. A vehicle parked in a general parking bay displaying a valid season ticket issued by the Council for that parking place is exempt from the parking charge.

41. A season ticket can be purchased from the Council for the charges set out in Schedule 5.
42. A season ticket is only valid in the parking place(s) in respect of which it was issued, for the vehicle(s) in respect of which it was issued and up to the date of expiry shown on the season ticket.
43. A season ticket shall be displayed in the relevant position on a vehicle in respect of which it was issued at all times during which the vehicle is parked in the parking place.
44. All provisions in this Order remain other than the requirement to pay.
45. The Council may withdraw or refuse to renew a season ticket if the Council is satisfied that a season ticket has been used contrary to the issuing conditions.
46. The Council may decline to issue any further season tickets or may request at any time that any or all current season tickets are surrendered.
47. A refund for unused eligibility may be requested by the season ticket holder by returning the season ticket to the Council.
48. The date used for the evaluation of a refund request will be the date that the returned season ticket is received by the Council.
49. The amount of any refund would be evaluated on the basis of wholly unused months, calculated on a pro rata basis.
50. If the Council instructs that the season ticket is to be surrendered then a partially used month would also be refunded on a pro rata basis.

#### Parking permits

51. A vehicle parked in a parking place displaying a valid parking permit issued by the Council to allow parking in that parking place is exempt from the parking charge.



52. A parking permit is provided by the Council for a specific vehicle subject to conditions set out by the Council at the time of issue.
53. A parking permit is only valid in the parking place(s) in respect of which it was issued up to the date of expiry shown on the parking permit.
54. The driver shall abide by the terms stipulated by the Council for the use of the parking permit.
55. Unless explicitly stated otherwise, a parking permit may only be used to park in general parking bays.
56. A parking permit shall be displayed in the relevant position on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued at all times during which the vehicle is parked in the parking place.

#### Exempt activities

57. Any vehicle being actively used for one of the activities set out in Schedule 7 is exempt from the parking charge while that activity is being carried out.

## **PART 5 RELOCATION, REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF VEHICLES**

#### Emergencies

58. A person authorised by the Council or a police officer in uniform may, using such measures as are appropriate, move or cause to be moved in the case of an emergency to any place he/she thinks fit, any vehicle parked in a parking place.

#### Contraventions in suspended parking place

59. A person authorised by the Council may, using such measures as are appropriate, move or cause to be moved to any place he/she thinks fit,

any vehicle parked in a parking place which has been closed or suspended in whole or in part by the Council and the cost of movement or removal and safe keeping shall be the liability of the owner of the vehicle.

#### Safe keeping

60. Any person removing a vehicle from a parking place under the provisions of this Order shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary to provide for the safe keeping of the vehicle.

#### Disposal of vehicles abandoned in parking places

61. The Council may sell or otherwise dispose of, in accordance with current legislation, a vehicle which has been, or could at any time be, removed from a parking place if the vehicle appears to have been abandoned.

### **PART 6**

#### **CONTRAVENTION AND PENALTY CHARGE**

#### Contravention

62. Save for the provisions in Part 7, if a vehicle is parked in a parking place without complying with the requirements of this Order, a contravention shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable. A penalty charge notice may then be issued and served and/or the vehicle may be removed from its location. All enforcement action shall be in terms of legislation and subsequent amendments.

#### Restriction on removal of notices

63. Any notice, including a penalty charge notice, fixed to a vehicle in accordance with this Order shall not be removed or interfered with except by or under the authority of:
- (i) the Owner or driver of the vehicle;
  - (ii) the Council for the parking place in which the vehicle in question was parked.

Indications as evidence

64. The particulars given in any notice served on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of this Order shall be treated as evidence in any proceedings relating to failure to pay the penalty charge.

**PART 7**

**LIABILITY AND OTHER PROVISIONS**

Liability

65. The Council accepts no liability for the loss or damage to vehicles or other property left in any of the parking places to which this Order applies save for that arising from the negligence of the Council.

Validity

66. If a court or The Traffic Penalty Tribunal declares any part of this Order to be invalid or un-enforceable, such declaration shall not invalidate the remainder of the Order.

Tax and Insurance

67. Any person who causes or permits any vehicle to wait in a parking place without the vehicle being licensed in pursuance of the provisions of the Vehicles Excise and Registration Act 1994 and without a current policy of insurance in relation to the use of the vehicle by the driver such as complies with the requirements of Part VI of the Road Traffic Act 1972 shall be liable to prosecution.

Driving within a parking place

68. Where in a parking place signs are erected or surface markings are laid for the purpose of
- (i) indicating the entrance to or exit from the parking place, or
  - (ii) indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place,
- any person who drives or permits to be driven any vehicle
- (i) so that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance,
- or

- (ii) leaves the parking place otherwise than by an exit so indicated,  
or
  - (iii) in a direction other than so specified
- shall be liable to prosecution.

69. Any person who, without with the permission of a person authorised by the Council in that behalf, drives or permits to be driven any vehicle in a parking place for any purpose other than the purpose of leaving that vehicle in the parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the parking place shall be liable to prosecution.

#### Wilful damage

70. Any person who with intent to defraud interferes with a ticket machine or operates or attempts to operate it by the insertion of objects other than undamaged and unaltered coins of legal tender and of the appropriate denomination, shall be liable to prosecution.
71. No person shall cause damage to any Council equipment, signing or lighting installations or other installations within the parking place or to any part of the fabric of the parking place and any person doing so shall be liable to prosecution.

#### Domestic purposes

72. Any person who uses any part of the parking place or any vehicle parked in a parking place
- (i) for sleeping or camping or cooking, or
  - (ii) for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable the vehicle to depart from the parking place
- shall be liable to prosecution.

### Behaviour

73. Any person who wilfully sounds any horn or any other similar instrument on a vehicle except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place shall be liable to prosecution.
74. Any person who in a parking place shouts or otherwise makes any loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of users of the parking place or residents or premises in the neighbourhood shall be liable to prosecution.
75. Any person who in a parking place uses any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned shall be liable to prosecution.

### Other activities

76. Any person who in a parking place
- (i) erects or causes or permits to be erected any skip, tent, booth, stand, building or other structure without the written consent of the Council, or
  - (ii) lights or causes to be lit any fire, or
  - (iii) conducts activities that do not relate directly to the parking of a vehicle in the parking place under the terms of use of the parking place
- shall be liable to prosecution.

## **PART 8**

### **REVOCATIONS**

#### Revocations

77. The Orders set out in Schedule 8 are hereby revoked.

  - (iv) Use in the service of any undertaker, the Environment Agency or any public authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties
  - (v) Use for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes
  - (vi) Use for the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets as defined by section 125 of the Postal Services Act 2000
  - (vii) Used for the delivery or collection of money or valuable securities by a vehicle specially equipped or adapted for that purpose
  - (viii) The removal of furniture or household effects to or from a shop, office, depository or dwelling house adjacent to the parking place
