The Council of the Borough of North East Lincolnshire, hereinafter referred to as "the Council", in exercise of powers conferred on the Council under Sections 32, 33 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984"), the Traffic Management Act 2004 (hereinafter referred to as "the TMA of 2004") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

### COMMENCEMENT INTERPRETATION AND REVOCATION

### Commencement and Citation

This Order may be cited as "The Borough of North East Lincolnshire (Off-Street Parking Places) (Amendment No. 2) Order 2013 and shall come into operation on the of , 2013

### 2 Interpretation

- 2.01 Any reference in this Order to a numbered Section or to a numbered Article is a reference to the Section or Article bearing that number in this Order and any reference in this Order to "Schedules 1, or 2" is a reference to Schedule 1 or Schedule 2 to this Order respectively.
- 2.02 In this Order all expressions, except where the context otherwise requires, shall have the meanings assigned to them:
  - (1) "apparatus" means a ticket issuing parking machine;
  - (2) "authorised vehicle" means a vehicle of a specified class authorised to use a Parking Place by virtue of Article 4 of this Order and as specified in the Schedules to this Order;
  - (3) "caravan" means any structure designed or adapted for human habitation which is capable of being moved from one place to another (whether by being towed or by being transported on a motor vehicle or trailer);
  - (4) "Civil Enforcement Officer" means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise any Parking Place and to enforce the restrictions imposed by this Order;
  - (5) "coach" means:
    - (a) a motor vehicle constructed or adapted to carry more than 14 passengers exclusive of the Driver);

or

- (b) a local bus not so constructed or adapted as defined in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;
- (6) "charging period" means the period from 8 o'clock in the forenoon on one day to 8 o'clock in the forenoon on the following day;
- (7) "Council" means the North East Lincolnshire Borough Council, and includes, unless a contrary intention appears, a person duly authorised by the Council to act on its behalf in connection with this Order;
- (8) "disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;

- (9) "disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;
- (10) "the person in charge" in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;
- (11) "hand-held device" means a wireless hand-held computer used by a civil enforcement officer which is programmed to interface with the any telephone payment parking system and enforcement system;
- (12) "heavy commercial vehicle" has the same meaning as that in the Highways Act 1980;
- (13) "immobilisation devices" has the same meaning as given by section 104(9) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
- (14) **"invalid carriage"** has the same meaning as in section 136 of the Act of 1984:
- (15) "motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 136 of the Act of 1984:
- (16) "motor cycle" has the same meanings as in section 136 of the Act of 1984 provided that for the purpose of this Order the term shall be deemed to refer only to a solo motor cycle;
- (17) "Off-Street Parking Places Order 2012" is a reference to The North East Lincolnshire Borough Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2012 as amended:
- (18) "parking bay" means any area of a parking place surface marked out, by means of white or yellow lines or otherwise for the leaving of a vehicle;
- (19) "parking place" means any area of land specified by name and described in the Schedules to this Order and shaded in red on the appropriate plans attached provided:
  - (a) by the Council under Section 32 of the Act of 1984 for use as a Parking Place;
  - (b) by any other person under Section 33(4)(b) of the Act of 1984 for use as a Parking Place;
- "passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle or Invalid Carriage) constructed or adapted solely for the carriage of not more than fourteen passengers (exclusive of the driver) and their effects and not drawing a trailer;
- (21) "pay and display ticket" means a ticket issued by a ticket machine located in the parking place in which the vehicle has been left or issued by a person nominated by the Council on payment of a charge and valid for a parking period as detailed in the Schedules;

- (22) "penalty charge" means a charge set by the Council under the provisions of Section 77 and Schedule 9 of the TMA of 2004 and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (Guidelines on Levels of Charges) (England) Order 2007 (as amended) which is to be paid to the Council within 28 days beginning with the date of issue endorsed upon the penalty charge notice;
- (23) "penalty charge notice" means a notice of Penalty Charge issued or served by a Civil Enforcement Officer pursuant to the provisions of Section 78 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007;
- (24) "permit" means any business and/or contract permit, Council members permit, Season Permit, Smart Park permit, Visitors permit, North Promenade, Central Promenade and Wardall Street Business permits, special events permit, general permit or residents permit (all of which may be issued electronically) issued by or on behalf of the Council allowing a vehicle to be parked in a specific parking place and a permit may specify conditions of use;
- (25) "person in charge of a vehicle" means the driver of a vehicle or the instructor of a person driving whilst holding a provisional licence for that vehicle;
- (26) "reduced penalty charge" means a charge set by the Council under the provisions of Section 77 and Schedule 9 of the TMA of 2004 and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (Guidelines on Levels of Charges) (England) Order 2007which is to be paid within 14 days following the date of issue endorsed on the penalty charge notice;
- "registered keeper" means the person in whose name the vehicle was registered under the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994;
- (28) "relevant date" means the date upon which any vehicle is or was parked in any parking place or upon which any event occurs or occurred in breach of any of the provisions of this Order or to which this Order relates;
- (29) "relevant position" means:-
  - (a) in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen the badge pass, permit or pay and display ticket as the case may be is exhibited thereon with the obverse side facing forwards on the near side of and affixed to the windscreen so that the same is readable from the outside of the vehicle;
  - (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the badge pass, permit or pay and display ticket as the case may be is exhibited in a conspicuous and readable position on the vehicle;
- (30) "specified charge for parking" means the fee payable for parking in a parking place as displayed on or adjacent to the ticket machine relating to that parking place;
- (31) "ticket machine" means apparatus or a device of a type and design approved by the appropriate Minister in accordance with Section (35)3 of the Act of 1984;
- (32) "trailer" has the same meaning as in section 136 of the Act of 1984.

- 2.03 For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:-
  - (1) a disabled person's badge in the "relevant position" when :
    - in the case of a vehicle fitted with a front windscreen, the badge is exhibited in full thereon with the parking card side facing forwards on the near side of and immediately behind the windscreen;
    - (b) in the case of a vehicle not fitted with a front windscreen the badge is exhibited fully in a conspicuous position on the front or near side of the vehicle;
  - (2) a parking disc in the "relevant position" when the disc is exhibited thereon with the side which shows the time facing fully forwards or outwards and immediately behind the windscreen or side window nearest the kerb.
- 2.04 The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

### PART II USE OF PARKING PLACES

### **Use of Parking Places** 3 Each of the areas of land specified by name and described in Schedule 1 may be used, 3.01 subject to the following provisions of this Order, as a parking place for such classes of vehicles, in such positions on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that area in Schedule 2 and no parking place shall be used by any person for any other purpose whatsoever. Where in Schedule 2 a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified 3.02 class or in a specified position, the person in charge of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking place unless it is of the specified class; (1) and (2)in the position so specified. The person in charge of a vehicle shall not wait or park on any yellow line or hatched 3.03 area or cause an obstruction or permit it to wait in a Parking Place other than in a Parking Bay and for this purpose, except with the permission of the Council and Civil Enforcement Officer, every part of the vehicle must be within the limits of the Parking Bay and not more than one vehicle shall occupy any one such Parking Bay. The person in charge of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a Parking Place or part 3.04 thereof that has been reserved by means of a sign or surface marking specifically for use by disabled persons or motorcycles or for loading and unloading or reserved for business unless: (1) Use of disabled person's bay the vehicle is displaying a valid Disabled Person's Badge, showing (a) the parking card and the disabled persons clock is set at the time of arrival; and the vehicle is carrying a registered disabled person at the time the (b) vehicle enters and leaves the Parking Bay and that person (whether the person in charge of the vehicle or a passenger) is the person to whom the badge was issued; (2)Use of motor cycle bay the vehicle is a solo motorcycle; (a) Use of loading and unloading bay (3)the vehicle is being loaded or unloaded; (a)

### (4) Use of reserved bay

- (a) the vehicle is displaying a relevant business permit, or has purchased an electronic permit for the parking place and the relevant extra charge has been paid to the Council.
- 3.05 The person in charge of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in Parking Place for longer than the maximum period permitted for waiting specified in Schedules to this Order in relation to that Parking Place.
- 3.06 When a vehicle has left a Parking Place after waiting therein the person in charge of the vehicle thereof shall not within one hour after its leaving permit it to wait again in that Parking Place
- 3.07 If parking bays are marked out in a parking place the driver of a vehicle shall ensure that it is positioned
  - (1) wholly within a parking bay appropriate for that vehicle and shall not permit it to wait in that parking place unless it is so positioned

or

- (2) If parking bays are not marked out in a parking place the driver of a vehicle shall ensure that it is positioned so that it does not obstruct: other vehicles using the parking place, the free flow of traffic circulating within the parking place, where a no parking sign is displayed and the entrances to and exits from the parking place.
- 3.08 The person in charge of a vehicle shall not cause or permit it to wait in a parking place specified in the Schedules hereto for longer than seven days together at any one time, notwithstanding the fact that the appropriate payment has been made.
- 3.09 Insofar as a vehicle is left in a parking place during the charging hours the person in charge thereof shall pay such charges as are specified in the following provisions of this Order.
- 3.10 The person in charge of a vehicle shall not permit that vehicle to wait in a parking place unless the vehicle is licensed in pursuance of the provisions of the Vehicle (Excise) Act 1971 and unless there is in relation to the use of the vehicle by the person in charge such a policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of Part VI of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
- 3.11 The person in charge of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place and shall not start the engine again except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
- 3.12 No person shall use a vehicle while it is in a parking place in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of their skill or services unless previously authorised in writing by the Council.
- 3.13 The person in charge of a vehicle using a parking place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.

No person shall except with the permission of a person authorised by the Council in that behalf drive or permit any vehicle in a parking place for any other purpose than the purpose of leaving that vehicle in a parking place in accordance with the provisions of this Order or for the purpose of departing from the parking place.

The Council does not undertake to supervise any Parking Place and entry to and exit from and use of the Parking Bays is entirely at the users risk and the Council or its servants or agents does not accept any liability for any damage to or loss of vehicles or their contents which arise from any act or omission outside its reasonable control unless directly caused by the negligence of its staff, agents or contractors.

### 4 Specified Charge For Parking

- 4.01 This Section applies to the parking places specified by name in Column 1 of Schedule 2.
- 4.02 The specified charge for a vehicle left in a parking place during the charging hours shall be that charge for each period of parking as set down in the Off-Street Parking Places Order 2012 in relation to each of the parking places referred to in Schedule 2 to this Order or by notice on site.
- 4.03 The specified charge shall be paid on the leaving of a vehicle in a parking place and the said charge shall be paid by the insertion of an appropriate coin or coins into the apparatus or device provided or by the insertion of a decremental magnetic card into the apparatus or device provided (if the apparatus or device provided is capable of accepting decremental magnetic cards), such apparatus being approved in accordance with Section 35(3) of the Act of 1984, and the provisions of Section 47(5) of the Act of 1984 shall apply in respect of such apparatus.
- 4.04 No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be parked during the charging hours in a pay and display parking place after the expiry of a displayed pay and display ticket.
- If at any time while a vehicle is parked in a pay and display parking place no pay and display ticket or permit is displayed on that vehicle in the relevant position and in accordance with the provisions of this order, it shall be deemed that the charge has not been paid. Notwithstanding that an electronic permit has been issued and the relevant charge paid to the Council.
- 4.06 If at the time when a vehicle is parked during the charging hours in a pay and display parking place and the nearest ticket machine in that parking place is out of order, then a pay and display ticket shall be obtained from another ticket machine within the same parking place (where provided) or as directed in the parking place. If a pay and display ticket cannot be obtained from the ticket machine(s) then the Council must be informed using the contact numbers displayed on the information signs within the car park immediately and before the vehicle is left in the parking place.
- 4.07 If at any time when a vehicle is left in a parking place during the prescribed hours there is no ticket issuing machine at that parking place or all the ticket issuing machines at that parking place carry notices placed upon them by authority of the Council indicating that they are out of order:
  - (1) the Council may arrange for tickets to be issued by a parking attendant and in this event all other terms and provisions of this Order shall have full force and effect;

or

(2) the person in charge of the vehicle shall be exempt from payment of the charge.

- 4.08 No daily charge or part thereof shall be payable in respect of;
  - (1) a vehicle parked in a pay and display parking place which displays in the relevant position a valid disabled person's badge provided that the vehicle immediately before or after the act of parking has been used or is about to be used by the person(s) in respect of whom the badge is issued;

or

(2) a motor cycle parked in a motor cycle bay;

or

- (3) a vehicle parked displaying in a relevant position a season ticket or business permit or parking permit issued by the Council valid for that parking place.
- (4) A vehicle parked in a relevant position which has been issued an electronic permit and the relevant charge paid to the Council valid for that parking place.
- 4.09 A prepaid parking ticket (hereinafter referred to as a "Permit") may be purchased from the Council by the person in charge or owner of a vehicle in respect of the parking places specified in the Off-Street Parking Places Order 2012 by payment of the appropriate charge.
- 4.10 The person in charge of any vehicle using a parking place specified in Schedule 2 where specified in Column 8 of the said Schedule reads Permit, shall be exempt from the provisions of Articles 4.02, 4.03 and 4.04 if the person has purchased a permit from the Council in respect of the period for which the person uses the parking place.
- 4.15 Any ticket issued on payment of the specified charge or permit issued in accordance with Article 4.09 Permit issued in accordance with Article 4.10 shall be attached in the relevant position to the vehicle in respect of which it was issued, unless issued electronically.
- 4.16 A vehicle shall not be left in a parking place if it displays an expired ticket or expired Permit or any other expired parking ticket issued by the Council.
- 4.17 The person in charge of any vehicle who, for the purpose of using a parking place specified in Schedule 1, has paid a charge in accordance with the provisions of this Order and who leaves such parking place before the expiry of the period appropriate to such a charge may during the unexpired part of such period use any other parking place specified in the said Schedule without payment of any further charge provided that the ticket obtained therefore is displayed in a conspicuous position on the windscreen, unless issued electronically, of the vehicle whilst it is in a parking place and that the period specified in Column 6 of Schedule 2 is not exceeded.

### 5 Contravention and Penalty Charge

- 5.01 Save for the provisions in Part 2, if a vehicle is parked in a parking place in contravention of or non-compliance with the requirements of this Order, said contravention or non-compliance shall have occurred and a penalty charge shall be payable.
- 5.02 The penalty charge or reduced penalty charge shall be in the sum of the following amounts:
  - (1) The penalty charge Band 2 as set out in Section 1 of The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (Guidelines on Levels of Charges) (England) Order 2007 subject to payment being received by the Council as provided in paragraph 6 of this Article within 28 days beginning with the date of issue of the penalty charge notice.
  - (2) The reduced penalty charge a 50 percent reduction of the penalty charge subject to payment being received by the Council as provided in paragraph 6 of this article within 14 days beginning with the date of issue of the penalty charge notice.
  - (3) On the issue of a charge certificate in accordance with the provisions of Regulation 21 of The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007 the penalty charge shall be increased by 50 percent.
  - (4) Where a penalty charge has been incurred a civil enforcement officer may attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position or hand to the driver a penalty charge notice which shall comply with the requirements of Regulation 9 and the Schedule to The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007.
  - (5) Where a penalty charge has been incurred a penalty charge notice may be issued by post by the enforcement authority if the owner of the vehicle drives the vehicle away before the civil enforcement officer has issued the penalty charge notice or the civil enforcement officer has been prevented from issuing a penalty charge notice, such a penalty charge notice shall comply with the requirements of Regulation 10 and the Schedule to The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions (England) General Regulations 2007.
  - (6) Payment of the penalty charge to the Council shall be either be by electronic transfer or cheque or postal order or cash in person which shall be delivered or sent by post so as to reach the relevant Department or Office of the Council as stated on the penalty charge notice no later than 4.30pm, by the date specified on the penalty charge notice but should the said Council Department or Office be closed on the said date specified the period for receiving payment may be extended until 4.30pm, on the next working day.
  - (7) The particulars given in the penalty charge notice attached to a vehicle or sent by post in accordance with this Article shall be treated as evidence in any proceedings relating to failure to pay such penalty charge.
- When a penalty charge notice has been attached to a vehicle in accordance with any of the foregoing provisions of this Order no person other than a person authorised by the Council in that behalf or the owner or driver or a person authorised by the owner or driver shall remove the penalty charge notice from the vehicle.

5.04 The Council or any officer authorised in that behalf may at its or their discretion quash the liability to pay a Penalty Charge to which the person in charge or registered keeper has become liable under this Article.

### 6 Relocation, Removal and Disposal of Vehicles

- 6.01 If a vehicle is left in a parking place in a position other than in accordance with provisions of Section 3 a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle so that its position is in accordance with the said provisions.
- 6.02 If a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the foregoing provisions of this Order a person authorised by the Council in that behalf may remove the vehicle from that parking place or arrange for such removal.
- For the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency a person authorised in that behalf by the Council or police constable in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of a vehicle in a parking place or remove or arrange for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place.
- Any person altering, or causing the alteration of the position of a vehicle by virtue of Article 6.01 or removing or causing the removal of a vehicle by virtue of Articles 6.02 or 6.03 may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or such other manner as they may think reasonably necessary to enable the position of the vehicle to be altered or the vehicle to be removed and shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.
- The Council may sell or otherwise dispose of, in accordance with current regulation, a vehicle which has been, or could at any time be, removed from a parking space if the vehicle appears to have been abandoned.

### 7 Suspension of a Parking Place

7.01 The Council may by notice suspend the use of a parking place or part thereof whenever it considers such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety, any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or for the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line or traffic sign or line, or for the exercise of any of the Council's powers or duties, and may also by notice suspend for such periods as it may specify all or any of the charges specified in this Order, and the person in charge of a vehicle shall not use a parking place when such a parking place has been so suspended by the Council.

# 8.01 The Council accepts no liability for injury to the public or the loss or damage to vehicles or other property left in any of the parking places to which this Order applies save for that arising from the negligence of the Council 8.02 If a court, the Department for Transport, the Traffic Penalty Tribunal or the Traffic Enforcement Centre declares any part of this Order to be invalid or unenforceable such declaration shall not invalidate the remainder of the Order.
