

NORTHAMPTON BOROUGH COUNCIL (WELLINGBOROUGH ROAD VICINITY)
(TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 1999

Northampton Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Northamptonshire County Council and in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) 4(2) 32(1) and 35(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order having been made on the ~~fourth~~ ^{twenty-fifth} day of June 1999 shall come into operation for all purposes on the ~~fourth~~ ^{first} day of July 1999 and may be cited as: Northampton Borough Council (Wellingborough Road Vicinity) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1999.
2. This Order is made for the purpose of a general scheme of traffic control in the Wellingborough Road vicinity.
3. In this Order except where the context otherwise requires the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

"accessway": a length of road sufficient to enable a vehicle to have access to and egress from land or premises in or adjacent to a parking place.

"buses" and "bus lane" have the same meanings as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994 (Regulations 22 and 23 respectively).

"delivering and collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection.

"disabled person's badge": has the same meaning as in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982.

"disabled person's parking disc": a disc issued by a local authority in accordance with the provisions of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986.

"disabled person's parking place": a length of road authorised to be used as a parking place for disabled persons' vehicles as specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.

"disabled person's vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986.

"driver": in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place.

"dual purpose vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Sixth Schedule to the Act.

"goods" include postal packets as defined by Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953, cash or other valuable securities.

"goods vehicle": a motor vehicle without a trailer which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods of any description the unladen weight of which exceeds 1525kg.

"light goods vehicle": a motor vehicle without a trailer which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods of any description the unladen weight of which does not exceed 1525kg.

"loading bay": a space in a parking space which is provided for the waiting of a vehicle for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading the vehicle at premises adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting.

"motor cycle and invalid carriage": have the same meaning respectively as in Section 136 of the Act.

"owner" in relation to a vehicle means the person by whom such vehicle is kept and used.

"parking place": a length of road authorised to be used as a parking place by this Order.

"parking space": a space in a parking place which is provided for the parking of a vehicle of the classes as specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.

"passenger vehicle": a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle or invalid carriage) constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted to carry not more than twelve passengers exclusive of the driver and not drawing a trailer.

"prescribed hours": the period between 7.30am and 6.00pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive any such day not being Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday being a public holiday.

"telecommunications apparatus" has the same meaning as in the Telecommunications Act 1984.

"traffic sign": a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the Act.

"traffic warden": a traffic warden employed by a police authority in pursuance of Section 95 of the Act.

- (2) The Orders specified in column 1 of Schedule 7 to this Order are hereby varied to the extent specified in column 2 of the said Schedule.
- (3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.
- (4) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
4. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
5. Where a vehicle, having been left in a parking place, remains there at the beginning of the prescribed hours, then the vehicle shall be treated for the purposes of this Order as if it had arrived in the parking place at the beginning of the prescribed hours.

6. Each of the parts of the roads specified in Schedule 1 of this Order is authorised to be used as a parking place subject to the following provisions of this Order during the prescribed hours for such vehicles or classes of vehicles and in such positions as are specified in relation to that part in the said Schedule provided that no such vehicle may by virtue of this Article wait in any part of a parking place which is a loading bay or access way.
7. Nothing in Article 6 of this Order shall restrict the power of the Council, (to close any parking place) preventing obstruction of the streets, by order on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination, or where the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed.
8. Where in Schedule 1 of this Order a parking place is described as available for vehicles of a specified class or in a specified position, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking place during the prescribed hours unless
 - (a) it is of the specified class or
 - (b) it is in the position specified in Schedule 1 of this Order
9. Where a figure is specified in Column 6 of Schedule 1 of this Order in relation to any area of carriageway described in Column 2 of the said Schedule there shall at all times be a part or parts of the said area of a total length in metres not less than that figure and of width equal to the width of the said area in which there shall be no parking space or part of a parking space.
10. The Council shall:-
 - (a) cause the limits of each parking place and where necessary each parking space in such designated parking places to be indicated on the carriageway by placing and maintaining thereon the appropriate traffic signs;
 - (b) place and maintain on or in the vicinity of each parking place appropriate traffic signs to indicate that such parking place may be used during the prescribed hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Schedule 1 of this Order; and
 - (c) carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place
11. The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a parking place for longer than the maximum period specified in Schedule 1 of this Order.
12. When a vehicle has left a parking place specified in Schedule 1 of this Order as limiting the use to 2 hours or less, the driver thereof shall not within one hour after its leaving permit it to wait again upon that parking place.
13. A member of the medical profession who is engaged in visiting a patient shall be exempt from the provisions of Article 8 of this Order.
14. A driver of a vehicle shall not use a parking place when, for preventing obstruction of the streets, the Council, by order made on the occasion of any public procession rejoicing or illumination or when the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed have closed that parking place and exhibited notice of such closing on or near the parking place.

15. The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
16. No person shall use a vehicle while it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.

Provided that nothing in this Article shall prevent the sale of goods from a vehicle:-

- (a) if the vehicle is a passenger vehicle, a dual purpose vehicle, a goods vehicle or a motor cycle (or an invalid carriage) and the goods are immediately delivered at or taken into premises adjacent to the vehicle from which the sale is effected; or
 - (b) if the vehicle is one to which the provisions of Article 17 of this Order apply.
17. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this Order, any vehicle may wait during the prescribed hours anywhere on the carriageway in a parking place (other than a parking place or part of a parking place the use of which has been suspended, under Article 20 of this Order) for so long as may be necessary if:-
- (a) the vehicle is waiting to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle is waiting owing to the driver being prevented from proceeding by circumstances beyond his control or to such waiting being necessary in order to avoid an accident;
 - (c) the vehicle is a vehicle used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or a vehicle (other than a passenger vehicle) in the service of a local authority which is being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
 - (d) the vehicle is waiting to enable it to be used in connection with the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (e) the vehicle is in the service of or employed by the Post Office and is waiting while postal packets addressed to premises adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting are being unloaded from the vehicle, or, having been unloaded therefrom are being delivered or while postal packets are being collected from premises or posting boxes adjacent to the parking place in which the vehicle is waiting, or is in use in connection with the servicing of telephone kiosks adjacent to the parking place;
 - (f) the vehicle (not being a passenger vehicle) is waiting to enable it to be used for any purpose specified in Article 20(1)(b) of this Order;
 - (g) the vehicle (not being a passenger vehicle) is in actual use in connection with the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository.
18. Where any vehicle is standing in a parking place in contravention of the provision of Articles 8, 11 and 14 of this Order a Traffic Warden or a police officer in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with those provisions.

19. A police officer in uniform or a Traffic Warden may in case of emergency move or cause to be moved any vehicle left in a parking place to any place he thinks fit.
20. (1) Any person authorised in writing by the Council may suspend the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary:-
- (a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;
 - (b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas water or electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus or traffic sign;
 - (c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwellinghouse to another or the removal of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository.
 - (d) on any occasion on which it is likely by reason of some special attraction that any street will be thronged or obstructed; or
 - (e) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals, or on other special occasions.
- (2) A police officer in uniform may suspend for not longer than twenty-four hours the use of a parking place or any part thereof whenever he considers such suspension reasonably necessary for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety.
- (3) Any person suspending the use of a parking place or any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (1) or paragraph (2) of this Article shall thereupon place or cause to be placed in or adjacent to that parking place or the part thereof the use of which is suspended a traffic sign indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.
- (4) No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be left in any parking place or part of a parking place during such period as there is in or adjacent to that parking place or part of a parking place a traffic sign placed in pursuance of paragraph (3) of this Article:
- Provided that nothing in this paragraph shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes or any vehicle being used for any purpose specified in Article 20(1)(b),(d) or (e) of this Order to be left in the parking place or part of a parking place during any such period, or to any other vehicle so left if that vehicle is left with the permission (i) of the persons suspending the use of the parking place or the part thereof in pursuance of paragraph (1) of this Article, (ii) of a police officer in uniform or (iii) of a traffic warden.

subject to the proviso hereto, where a traffic warden is of the opinion that any of the provisions contained in Articles 8, 9, 11, 14 and 20 (b) of this Order have been contravened or not complied with in respect of a vehicle left in a parking place, he may remove or cause to be removed the vehicle from the parking place, and, where it is so removed, he shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle:-

Provided that when a vehicle is waiting in a parking place in contravention of the provision of Article 8 of this Order, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.

22. Any person removing a vehicle or altering its position by virtue of Articles 19 and 21 may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position as the case may be.

23. Every vehicle left in a parking place in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Order shall so stand:-

(a) in the case of a parking place in relation to which special provisions as to the manner of standing of vehicles in that place are specified in column 3 of Schedule 1 to this Order, so as to be in accordance with those provisions:

(b) in the case of any other parking place:-

(i) that the left or near side of the vehicle is adjacent to the left-hand edge of the carriageway:

(c) so that every part of the vehicle is within the limits of a parking place or space where indicated.

24. Save as provided in Article 25 of this Order no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in those lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order between the hours of 7.30am to 9.30am Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.

Save as provided in Article 25 of this Order no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in those lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 to this Order at any time

25. The provisions of Article 24 hereto shall not apply:-

(a) to a fire engine or an ambulance or any vehicle in the service of a local authority or police force in either case being used in pursuance of statutory powers or duties if it is reasonably necessary for that vehicle to enter proceed or wait on the bus lane

(b) to anything done with the permission of a police officer in uniform

(c) to enable the vehicle, to be used in connection with any wedding, funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the roads or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the bus lane of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984 provided that in all the circumstances it is reasonably necessary for the vehicle to enter the bus lane, or as the case may be, to wait in the bus lane.

- (d) so as to prevent any vehicle from entering or leaving land or premises adjacent to the bus lane.
- (e) so as to prevent any vehicle from loading/unloading save between the hours of 7.30 am and 9.30 am Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.
- (f) to buses, Hackney Carriage Vehicles licensed by Northampton Borough Council and pedal cycles (other than pedal cycles which are motor vehicles within the meaning of the Road Traffic Act 1988)

26. Save as provided in Articles 27, 28 and 29 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time in those lengths of roads specified in Schedule 4 hereto. Save as provided in Articles 27, 28 and 29 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00am to 6.00pm Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in those lengths of roads specified in Schedule 4 A hereto.

Save as provided in Articles 27, 28 and 29 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 7.30am to 9.30am Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in those lengths of roads specified in Schedule 4 B hereto.

27. ~~Nothing in Article 26 hereto shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait for so long as may be necessary:-~~

- (a) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle
- (b) to enable loading and unloading

Provided that no person shall cause any vehicle to so wait between the hours of 7.30am to 9.30am Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in those lengths of road specified in Schedule 5 of this order

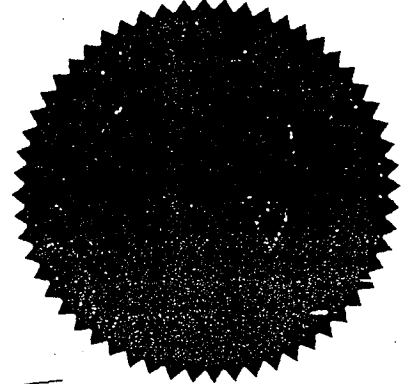
~~Provided further that no person shall cause any vehicle to so wait between the hours of 4.00pm to 6.00pm Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in those lengths of roads specified in Schedule 6 of this order~~

- (c) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other roads, to be used in connection with any wedding, funeral, building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the roads so referred to or the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or near the said roads or any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984 or
- (d) to enable the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other roads, to be used in the service of the local authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

28. Nothing in Article 26 hereto save where the loading/unloading restrictions referred to in Schedule 5 and 6 apply and save where any lengths of roads referred to which are bus lanes when the said bus lanes are in operation shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any disabled persons vehicle as defined in the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986 from waiting in the lengths of roads specified if the vehicle properly bears in the prescribed position a disabled persons badge as defined in the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982.

29. Nothing in Article 26 hereto shall apply to anything done with the permission of a police officer in uniform.
30. Notwithstanding any exemption granted by this Order the person in control of a vehicle waiting in a bus lane shall move the vehicle on the instructions of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden whenever such action may be necessary for the purpose of preventing or removing the cause of obstruction.
