Northamptonshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 32, 35 to 39 and 45 to 55 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984"), as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and with the Traffic Management Act 2004, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 13th April 2012 and may be cited as "The Northamptonshire County Council (Corby District) (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Amendment No. 5) Order 2012".
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, "The Northamptonshire County Council (Corby District) (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009" shall continue in full force and effect subject to the incorporation of new plans and/or amendments to existing plans identified in Schedule 1 attached to this Order.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northamptonshire County Council have made an Order under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 32, 35 and 45 to 55 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and the Traffic Management 2004 to amend "The Northamptonshire County Council (Corby District) (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009" as specified in the Schedule below.

A **COPY** of the Order, together with a plan showing the exact lengths of road to which it relates may be inspected at Corby Library, The Cube, Parklands Gateway, George Street, Corby during its normal opening hours or at the offices of The Traffic Order Section, Riverside House, Bedford Road, Northampton, NN1 5NX during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the date of this Notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.

This Order will become effective on the 13th of April 2012.

SCHEDULE

PROPOSED NO WAITING AT ANY TIME (CORBY)

Turner Road – west side – from its junction with Jubilee Avenue / Westcott Way roundabout to just past property no.2; Turner Road – east side – from its junction with Jubilee Avenue / Westcott Way roundabout to the boundary of property numbers 1 and 3; Turner Road / Leighton Road – whole junction (excluding the east side of Turner Road); Turner Road / Constable Road – whole junction (excluding the west side of Turner Road); Cottingham Road – south side – from its junction with George Street to just past The Salvation Army Hall; Montrose Street / Argyll Street – whole junction (excluding the south side of Argyll Street); Argyll Street – west side – from its junction with Stuart Road to just past Lorne Court; Lorne Court / Argyll Street – whole junction (excluding the east side of Argyll Street); Argyll Street / Stuart Road – whole junction (excluding the south side of Stuart Road); Stuart Road / Wheatley Avenue – whole junction; Campbell Road / Stuart Road – whole junction (excluding the north side of Stuart Road); Campbell Road / Connell Court – whole junction (excluding the east side of Campbell Road); Campbell Road / Cupar Crescent – whole junction (excluding the west side of Campbell Road).

PROPOSED DISABLED PARKING BAYS (CORBY)

Elizabeth Street – south side – one bay each side of the bus stop adjacent to The Dental Centre.

PROPOSED NO WAITING 9 am TO 6 pm MON - SAT (CORBY)

Stuart Road – north side – between its junctions with Wheatley Avenue and Argyll Street and between its junctions with Argyll Street and Campbell Road.
