THE NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (SHEEP STREET, WELLINGBOROUGH) (BUS LANE) ORDER 2012

Northamptonshire County Council ("the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections I and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-


- This Order may be cited as "The Northamptonshire County Council (Sheep Street, Wellingborough) (Bus Lane) Order 2012" and shall come into operation on the 27th January 2012.
- 2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order no person shall, except with the permission of or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any motor vehicle, except buses, to proceed between the hours of 7am and 7pm, along that length of the south-west side of Sheep Street, Wellingborough between a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Tithe Barn Road and a point 69 metres north-west of that junction
- 3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the length of road specified in the schedule below if the vehicle is being used for any the following purposes.
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations.
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic.
 - (iii) the maintenance improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road.
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said length of road or any sewer or of any main, pipe or operators for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telegraphic line as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878.
 - (v) in the service of a Local Authority or of a Water Company in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
 - (vi) police, fire or ambulance purposes.
 - (vii) street cleansing.
 - (viii) to gain access to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to the said length of road.
 - (ix) Network Rail Incident Response purposes.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Northamptonshire County Council have made an Order under Sections 1 and 2 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit any motor vehicle, except buses from proceeding between the hours of 7am and 7pm, along that length of south-west side of Sheep Street, Wellingborough between a point 10 metres north-west of its junction with Tithe Barn Road and a point 69 metres north-west of that junction.

A COPY of the Order, together with a plan showing the exact lengths of road to which it relates may be inspected at Wellingborough Library, Pebble Lane, Wellingborough during its normal opening hours or at the offices of The Traffic Order Section, Riverside House, Bedford Road, Northampton, NN1 5NX during normal opening.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the date of this Notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.

This Order will become effective on the 27th of January 2012.
