Northamptonshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984"), as amended and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other powers them enabling and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and with the Traffic Management Act 2004, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 28<sup>th</sup> June 2013 and may be cited as "The Northamptonshire County Council (South Northamptonshire District) (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Amendment No. 5) Order 2013".
2. Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into operation of this Order, "The Northamptonshire County Council (South Northamptonshire District) (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009" shall continue in full force and effect subject to the incorporation of the amendments detailed on the plans identified in Schedule 1 attached to this Order.
3. Article 6 of "The Northamptonshire County Council (South Northamptonshire District) (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009" is hereby amended to read "Article 6 (a)".
4. Insert into "The Northamptonshire County Council (South Northamptonshire District) (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009" the following new Article:-
  - 6 (b) Save as provided in Articles 7 to 12 of this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or authorised officer, cause or permit any goods vehicle exceeding 5 tonnes maximum gross weight to wait on the roads or sides of the roads identified and for the periods identified on the plans listed in Schedule 1 attached to this Order.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Northamptonshire County Council have made an Order under Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to amend "The Northamptonshire County Council (South Northamptonshire District) (Waiting and Loading Restrictions and On-Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2009" as specified in the Schedule below.

**A COPY** of the Order, together with a plan showing the exact lengths of road to which it relates may be inspected at Towcester Library, Richmond Road, Towcester during its normal opening hours or at the offices of The Traffic Order Section, Riverside House, Bedford Road, Northampton during normal office hours.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provisions contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act, or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from the date of this Notice apply to the High Court for this purpose.

This Order will become effective on the 28<sup>th</sup> of June 2013.
