Northumberland County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 35, 32, 45 and 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984"), and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 10 April 2012 and may be cited as "Northumberland County Council South East Northumberland Area (Parking Places) Composite Order 2011 – Amendment No 1 Order 2012".

2. In the Order:-

"Order" means "Northumberland County Council South East Northumberland Area (Parking Places) Composite Order 2011".

"Amendment Order" means "Northumberland County Council South East Northumberland Area (Parking Places) Composite Order 2011 – Amendment No 1 Order 2011".

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

3. Provisions

The following provisions shall be additions to, deletions from, or substitutions in the restrictions detailed in the Order:

(A) Additions

(1) New Items into Part I – Preliminary - Article 2. Interpretation - of the Order:

In this order, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

"The 2000 Regulations" means the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;

"The 2002 Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"ambulance" has the same meaning as Schedule 2 of the Vehicle Excise and Registration Act 1994;

"car club vehicle" a shared use vehicle available for hire by Car Club members and being used within an organised scheme operated by or on behalf of a contractor authorised by the Council"

"Council" means Northumberland County Council;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the 2000 Regulations;

"disabled person's parking place" means a parking place specified in Schedule 4

"disabled persons vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000;

"driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"electric vehicle" shall have the same meaning as in the Waste Batteries and Accumulators Regulations 2009.

"emergency vehicle" means a vehicle as defined by regulation 3 of the Road Vehicles Lighting Regulations 1989 (SI 1989/1796);

"goods" means goods of any kind whether animate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description and "delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"goods vehicle" means a motor vehicle which is constructed or adapted for use for the carriage of goods or burden of any description and is not drawing a trailer;

"invalid carriage" has the same meanings as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;

"Limited Waiting Parking Place" means a parking place specified in Schedule 2

"maximum permitted stay" means the maximum time that a vehicle may be left in a parking place as defined in column 9 of Schedule 2 or 3;

"motorcycle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;

"Northumberland County Wide permit" means a Permit issued by the Council in accordance with Article 11;

"owner" in relation to a vehicle, means the person by whom such a vehicle is kept and used;

"parking bay" means a marked area in a parking place referred to in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9 or 10 for the leaving of a vehicle;

“parking device” has the same meanings as in Section 51 of the Act of 1984;

“parking dispensation” means a dispensation issued by the Council in accordance with Article 19;

“parking place” means any area on a highway referred to in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9 or 10;

“parking space” means an unmarked area in a parking place referred to in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9 or 10;

“pay and display parking place” means parking place specified in Schedule 3

“passenger vehicle” means a motor vehicle (other than a motorcycle or invalid carriage) constructed or adapted solely for the carriage of not more than eight passengers (exclusive of the driver) and their effects and not drawing a trailer;

“permit” means a residents permit, visitor’s permit, Northumberland County Wide permit or a weekly tourist permit issued under the conditions of Article 11;

“permit holder” means a residents permit holder, visitor’s permit holder, Northumberland County Wide permit or a weekly tourist permit to whom a permit has been issued under the provisions of Article 11;

“permit holder parking place” means a parking place specified in Schedules 1, 2 or 3;

“permitted hours” in relation to a parking place, means the times of operation specified in Schedule 6 as represented by the corresponding time code in column 6 of Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9 or 10 of this order relating to that parking place;

“police vehicle” has the same meaning as in Section 1 of the 2002 Regulations;

“provision of a universal postal service”, “universal service provider” and “postal packet” have the same meanings as in the Postal Services Act 2000;

“recharging post” means a device designed for the recharging of Electrical Vehicle.”

“relevant position” in respect of a disabled persons badge means the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position clearly visible in the front or near side of the vehicle;

“resident” means a person whose usual place of abode is at premises the postal address of which is in any street or part of a street in Northumberland;

“resident’s permit” means a Permit issued by the Council in accordance with Article 11;

“road marking” has the same meaning as in Regulation 25 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

“street” includes any part of a street;

“telecommunication system” has the same meaning as in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

“ticket” means a ticket issued by a ticket machine relating to a parking place referred to in Schedule 3;

“ticket machine” means an apparatus of a type and design approved by the Secretary of State for Transport, for the purposes of this Order being an apparatus designed to issue a ticket indicating the payment of the parking charge referred to in Article 13 and to indicate the time by which the parking period for which payment was made by the parking charge will expire;

“traffic sign” means a sign of any size, type and colour prescribed and authorised under, or as having effect as though prescribed or authorised under Section 64 of the Act of 1984;

“vehicle” has the same meaning as that assigned to “motor vehicle” in section 136(1) of the Act of 1984;

“visitor” means a person who is visiting a resident and who has obtained a visitors permit from and with the permission of that resident;

“visitor’s permit” means a Permit issued by the Council in accordance with Article 11;

“weekly tourist permit” means a Permit issued by the Council in accordance with Article 11;

“zone” means the parking zone within which a permit is valid.

(2) Part II Parking Places – 4. Designation of parking places of the Order

Any length of road specified in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9 or 10 of this Order as a parking place is hereby designated as a parking place.

(3) Part II Parking Places – 6. Vehicles for which parking places are designated of the Order

Each parking place specified in Schedules 1, 2, 3, 4, 8, 9 or 10 of this Order may be used, subject to the provisions of this Order, for the leaving during the permitted hours of such vehicles as are Passenger Vehicles, Goods Vehicles, Motorcycles or Invalid Carriages provided that the use of that Parking Place or part of the Parking Place in which the Vehicle is left has not been suspended.

In the case of a parking place as defined in Column 8 of Schedule 8 of this Order as police, a POLICE VEHICLE.

In the case of a parking place as defined in Column 8 of Schedule 9 of this Order as car club, a CAR CLUB VEHICLE.

In the case of a parking place as defined in Column 8 of Schedule 10 of this Order as electric vehicle, a ELECTRIC VEHICLE.
