Northumberland County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under sections 32 and 35 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers and after consulting the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby make the following Order:

PART I – PRELIMINARY

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 4th May 2010 and may be cited as "Northumberland County Council (Off Street Parking Places) Composite Order 2010".

2. Interpretation

In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires:

"The 2000 Regulations" means the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 2000;

"The 2002 Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002;

"builder's skip" has the meaning given to it in section 139(11) of the Highways Act 1980;

"car" means a motor car within the meaning of section 136 of the Act of 1984;

"chargeable hours" means the hours during which the parking charge must be paid;

"coach" means a "Public Service Vehicle" with the same meaning as in section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981;

"coach bay" means any area of a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a coach and indicated by markings on the surface of the parking place;

"conspicuous position" means, in relation to Articles 6 and 7 of this Order, that the ticket or permit shall be attached near to the windscreen or drivers window of the motor vehicle in respect of which it was issued so that the validity of the ticket or permit is clearly visible from outside of the motor vehicle;

"day" in relation to Column 5 of Schedule 1 means a period of 24 hours from midnight to midnight;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the 2000 Regulations as amended;

"disabled persons vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000 as amended;

"driver" in relation to a parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"excess charge" has the meaning assigned to it by section 46(1) of the Act of 1984;

"excess charge notice" means a notice that shall be issued to indicate that an excess charge is payable as defined in Article 9 of this Order;

"heavy commercial vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 138 of the Act of 1984;

"invalid carriage" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;

"motor cycle" has the same meanings as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;

"motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in Section 136 of the Act of 1984;

"Northumberland County Wide Parking Permit" means a permit purchased from the Council under the provisions of Article 7 of this Order;

"owner" in relation to a vehicle has the same meaning as in Section 68 of the Road Traffic Offenders Act 1988;

"operational days and operational hours" means the days and hours during which the parking place is open and vehicles may wait;

"parking attendant" means a person authorised by or on behalf of the Council to supervise any parking place;

"parking bay" means any area in a parking place which is provided for the leaving of a vehicle as indicated by markings on the surface of the parking place;

"parking charge" means the charge for leaving a vehicle in a parking place;

"parking device" has the same meaning as in Section 35 of the Act of 1984;

"parking disc" means a parking device issued by or on behalf of the Council which is capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins;

"parking ticket" means a ticket or tickets purchased from a ticket machine;

"parking place" has the meaning given to it in Article 4 of this Order;

"passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle constructed or adapted solely for the carriage of not more than eight passengers (exclusive of the driver) and their effects and not drawing a trailer;

"permit" without more means a Northumberland County Wide Parking Permit, Temporary/Restricted Permit or Weekly Tourist Permit;

"Temporary/Restricted Permit" means a permit issued by the Council under the provisions of Article 7 as defined in Schedule 3 of this Order;

"ticket machine" means an apparatus or device of a type approved in accordance with Section 35(3) of the Act of 1984;

"van" means a motor vehicle constructed or adopted for use for the conveyance of goods or burden and whose laden weight does not exceed three tonnes;

"vehicle" means a vehicle constructed or adapted solely for use on a road and not drawing a trailer;

"Weekly Tourist Permit" means a permit issued by the Council under the provisions of Article 7 as defined in Schedule 3 of this Order.

3. General

- (i) The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act of 1984 or by or under any other enactment.
- (ii) Where an Act of Parliament referred to in this Order or any Regulation Direction or Order made under it is repealed and new provisions enacted (with or without modifications) then the new provisions shall be substituted in this Order where relevant.
- (iii) The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

PART II – USE OF LAND AND PARKING PLACE

4. Designation of Parking Places

- (i) Each area of land specified by name in Column 2 of Schedule 1 may be used as a parking place subject to the provisions of this Order for such classes of vehicles, in such positions on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that area in Schedule 1.
- (ii) Nothing in Article 4(1) above shall authorise the use of any part of any parking place or of the roads adjacent to any parking place so as to unreasonably prevent access to any premises adjoining thereto or so as to cause a nuisance to any person.

5. Restrictions on use of Parking Places

- (i) The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in any parking place except in a position where it is authorised to wait by virtue of Column 3 of Schedule 1.

- (ii) The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in any parking place unless the vehicle is of a class authorised to wait in that parking place by virtue of Column 4 of Schedule 1.
- (iii) The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in any parking place outside of the operational days and operational hours specified in Column 5 to Schedule 1
- (iv) The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in any parking place during the chargeable hours specified in Column 6 to Schedule 1 unless the parking charge has been paid as specified in the following provisions of this Order.
- (v) The driver of a vehicle waiting in a parking place shall not permit it to wait there longer than the maximum length of stay specified in Column 7 of Schedule 1 during the chargeable hours in relation to that parking place.
- (vi) The driver of a vehicle waiting in a parking place who has paid the parking charge specified under Article 6 of this Order shall not permit it to wait there after the expiry of the maximum length of stay permitted during the chargeable hours as indicated by the parking ticket.
- (vii) The driver of a vehicle waiting in a parking place who has displayed a permit as specified under Article 7 of this Order shall not permit it to wait there after the expiry of the maximum length of stay permitted during the chargeable hours as indicated by the parking disc.
- (viii) Where, in a parking place, there is a sign or surface marking which indicates that a parking bay or part of the parking place is available only for a disabled person's vehicle, the driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in that parking bay or that part of the parking place (as the case may be) unless it is a disabled person's vehicle.
- (ix) The driver of a vehicle shall not exhibit thereon any parking ticket which has been altered, defaced, mutilated or amended or upon which the figures or particulars have become illegible.

6. The Charging Provision

- (i) This article applies on each occasion that a vehicle is left in a parking place during the chargeable hours relating to that parking place. When a vehicle is in a parking place outside the chargeable hours during the operational days and operational hours and has not been removed before the start of the next period of chargeable hours then for the purposes of this article that vehicle shall be deemed to have been left in the parking place at the start of that period of chargeable hours.
- (ii) The driver of a vehicle waiting in a parking place during the chargeable hours shall immediately on leaving the vehicle in the parking place pay the appropriate parking charge set out in Column 8 to Schedule 1 as defined in Schedule 2 to this Order. The charge shall be payable by:
 - (a) the insertion of the appropriate coin or combination of coins; or
 - (b) the insertion of a credit card where a card payment facility exists;

into the ticket machine provided for use at that parking place.

- (iii) It is the responsibility of the driver to ensure that all monies inserted into the ticket machine have registered before a parking ticket is printed. Payment of part of the parking charge, whether more or less than the exact amount defined in Schedule 2 to this Order will not result in a parking ticket being issued for a proportion of duration of stay greater or less than that specified in Schedule 2.
- (iv) The driver of a vehicle waiting in a parking place shall exhibit any parking ticket issued from a ticket machine under Article 6(ii) above in a prominent position on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued.

7. Parking permits

- (i) The owner of a vehicle of the class specified in Article 4 may apply to the Council for the issue of a Northumberland County Wide Parking Permit to facilitate the leaving of that vehicle in a parking place.
 - (1) On receipt of an application made under the foregoing provisions, the Council may issue to the applicant a permit and parking disc the requisite type for that parking place.
 - (2) The charge for a permit is as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
 - (3) The issue of and validity of any permit shall be solely at the discretion of the Council.
- (ii) The owner of a vehicle of the class specified in Article 4 may apply to the Council for the issue of a Temporary/Restricted Permit to facilitate the leaving of that vehicle in a parking place.
 - (1) On receipt of an application made under the foregoing provisions, the Council may issue to the applicant a Temporary/Restricted Permit for that parking place.
 - (2) The charge for a Temporary/Restricted Permit is as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
 - (3) The issue of and validity of any Temporary/Restricted Permit shall be solely at the discretion of the Council.
- (iii) The owner of a vehicle of the class specified in Article 4 may apply to the Council for the issue of a Weekly Tourist Permit to facilitate the leaving of that vehicle in a parking place.
 - (1) On receipt of an application made under the foregoing provisions, the Council may issue to the applicant a Weekly Tourist Permit for that parking place.
 - (2) The charge for a Weekly Tourist Permit is as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
 - (3) The issue of and validity of any Weekly Tourist Permit shall be solely at the discretion of the Council.

- (iv) The driver of a vehicle waiting in a parking place shall exhibit any permit and parking disc issued under Article 7(i), (ii) or (iii) above in a prominent position on the vehicle in respect of which it was issued and mark on the parking disc the time at which the period of waiting began.

8. Other Provisions

- (1) The driver of a vehicle shall not permit that vehicle to wait in a parking place unless the vehicle is licensed in pursuance of the provisions of the Vehicle (Excise) Act 1971 and unless there is in relation to the use of the vehicle by the driver such a policy of insurance as complies with the requirements of Part VI of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
- (2) The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in order to depart from the parking place.
- (3) No person shall use any part of a parking place for sleeping or camping or cooking, or for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the parking place.
- (4) No person shall use a parking place or any part thereof as an operating centre within the meaning of section 7 of the Goods Vehicles (Licensing of Operators) Act 1995 under a goods vehicle operator's licence.
- (5) The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall not sound any horn or other similar instrument except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.
- (6) Where in any parking place there is a sign or surface marking for the purpose of indicating the entrance or exit of the parking place; or indicating that a vehicle using the parking place shall proceed in a specified direction within the parking place; no person shall drive or permit to be driven any vehicle:
- (i) so that it enters the parking place otherwise than by an entrance or leaves the parking place otherwise than by an exit so indicated; or
 - (ii) in a direction other than specified.
- (7) No person shall use any parking place as a means of passage for proceeding from one road to another road without the prior written consent of the Council.
- (8) No person shall insert into a ticket machine relating to a parking place any coins additional to those inserted by way of payment of the appropriate charge for parking a vehicle in that parking place.
- (9) No person shall in a parking place:
- (i) erect or cause or permit to be erected any tent booth stand building awning or structure without the written consent of the Council;
 - (ii) light or cause or permit to be lit any fire; or

- (iii) deposit any builder's skip without the prior written permission of the Council.
- (10) No person shall in a parking place use any threatening, abusive or insulting language, gesture or conduct with intent to put any person in fear or so as to occasion a breach of the peace or whereby a breach of the peace is likely to be occasioned.
- (11) No person shall in a parking place wantonly shout or otherwise make a loud noise to the disturbance or annoyance of any user of the parking place or any occupier owner or resident of premises in the vicinity of the parking place.

9. Trading etc. in Parking Places

- (i) No person shall without the prior written consent of the Council use a vehicle when it is in a parking place in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.
- (ii) If the Council gives its consent to trading then the consent may be subject to such conditions as the Council shall think fit and the Council may if it thinks fit withdraw the consent at any time without giving that person prior notice.

10. Excess Charges

- (i) If any person contravenes Articles 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, or 9 of this Order then an excess charge shall become payable and an excess charge notice shall be issued.
- (ii) The amount of excess charge referred to in Article 10(1) above shall be as set out in Schedule 4, depending upon the date upon which payment is received by the Council.
- (iii) In the case of a vehicle in respect of which an excess charge may have become payable a parking attendant shall be empowered to attach to the vehicle in a conspicuous position an excess charge notice which shall include the following particulars:
 - (a) the registration number of the vehicle or, where the vehicle is being used under a trade licence, the number of the trade plate carried by the vehicle;
 - (b) the time at which he first observed that the excess charge had become payable;
 - (c) a statement that the excess charge is required to be paid and will be reduced if paid within fourteen days and stating the amount to be paid in either case;
 - (d) the manner in which, and the time within which, the excess charge must be paid; and
 - (e) a statement that it is an offence for the driver of a vehicle who has left the vehicle in a parking place to fail duly to pay the excess charge.

11. Restriction on removal of Notices and Tickets

- (i) Where a ticket has been displayed on a vehicle in accordance with the provisions of Article 6, no person other than the driver of the vehicle shall remove the ticket from the vehicle unless authorised to do so by the driver of the vehicle.
- (ii) Where a parking attendant has attached a notice to any vehicle in a parking place in accordance with the provisions of Article 10, no person other than a person authorised by the Council in that behalf or the driver or a person authorised by the driver shall remove the notice from the vehicle.

12. Removal of Vehicles

- (i) If a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any provision of this Order, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove or arrange for it to be removed from the parking place or may alter its position in the parking place.
- (ii) For the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency, a person authorised by the Council or a police constable in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of a vehicle in a parking place or arrange for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place.
- (iii) Any person removing or altering the position of a vehicle pursuant to Article 12 (1) or (2) of this Order may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as he may think necessary to enable him to remove it or alter its position as the case may be.

13. Suspension of Parking Places

The Council may at any time and for any period close or suspend the use of any parking place or any part thereof provided that they give clear notice that the parking place or part thereof (as the case may be) is closed or suspended.

14. Occasional Reservation of Spaces

The Council may, by a permit issued under the hand of its Chief Executive or delegated officer, relax any requirements imposed under this Order in relation to a particular vehicle or a particular person or persons for a particular period specified in the permit.

PART III – EXEMPTIONS

15. Disabled Parking

The driver of a vehicle need not pay the charge referred to in Article 6 of this Order if the vehicle is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in a conspicuous position a disabled person's badge.

16. Permit Holders

The driver of a vehicle which displays in a conspicuous position a valid Northumberland County Wide Parking Permit, Temporary/Restricted Permit or

Weekly Tourist Permit left in a parking place shall be exempt from any payment specified in Article 6 of this Order.

PART V – OPERATIONS

17. Contravention of restrictions

Save as provided in Articles 15 and 16 of this Order, if a vehicle is left in a parking place defined in Schedule 1 during the operational days and operational hours without complying with the provisions of this Order, a contravention shall be deemed to have occurred.

PART IV – REVOCATIONS

18. Revocations

Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, all Off Street Parking Places in Northumberland are hereby revoked.
