The Northumberland County Council, in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby make the following order:

1. Commencement and Citation

1.1 This Order shall come into operation on 3rd April 2017 until the 3rd April 2018 and may be cited as the "The County of Northumberland West Northumberland Area (Waiting and Loading) Composite Order 2011 Amendment No. 40 Experimental Order 2017."

2. Interpretation

- 2.1 In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:
- 2.1.1 "Council" means Northumberland County Council
- 2.1.2 "The Act" means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
- 2.2 Any reference in this order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent re-enactment.
- 2.3 "The Principal Order" means West Northumberland Area (Waiting and Loading) Composite Order 2011 (TRO_007)

3. General

- 3.1 The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirements imposed by any Regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
- 3.2 Where an Act of Parliament referred to in this Order or any Regulation, Direction or Order made under it is repealed and new provisions enacted (with or without modifications) new provisions shall be substituted in this Order where relevant.
- 3.3 Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered article or schedule is a reference to the article or schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- 3.4 The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

4. Additions and suspensions of Waiting and Loading Restrictions

- 4.1 Additions There shall be added to Schedule 1 of the Principal Order the waiting restrictions specified in the First Schedule of this Experimental Order.
- 4.2 Suspensions None

5. Supplementary Provisions

- 5.1 The operation of this Experimental Order or any provision of it may be modified or suspended by the Council's Executive Director of Local Services if it appears to him essential –
- (a) in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic;
- (b) in the interests of providing suitable and adequate on-street parking facilities, or
- (c) for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the order runs.

This power shall be exercised only after consulting the appropriate chief officer of police and giving such public notice as the Secretary of State may direct.

6. Revocations

STATEMENT OF THE COUNCIL'S REASONS FOR MAKING THE ORDER

The general effect of this Experimental Order will be to extend the 'No Waiting at Any Time' parking restrictions around the Radcliffe road/Church Street junction in Haydon Bridge, on an experimental basis.

The reason for introducing these restrictions by way of an Experimental Order is to allow amendments to be made if the restriction has not been extended far enough to resolve highway safety concerns in the area.

Consideration will be given after a trial period as to whether or not the provisions of this Experimental Order should be made permanent. Currently, at the end of the trial period, the Council intends to consider making an order which will continue in force indefinitely having the same effect as the Experimental Traffic Regulation Order.

The effects of this Order will be reviewed after 12 months
