Northumberland County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 32, 35 and Paragraphs 20 and 27 of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984"), and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:-

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 21st November 2016 and may be cited as "Northumberland County Council Off Street Parking Places Composite Order 2014 - Amendment No 04 Order 2016".

2. In the Order:-

"Order" means "Northumberland County Council Off Street Parking Places Composite Order 2014".

"Amendment Order" means "Northumberland County Council Off Street Parking Places Composite Order 2014 - Amendment No 04 Order 2016".

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.







STATEMENT OF THE COUNCILS REASONS FOR MAKING THE ORDER

The Traffic Regulation Order is necessary in order to introduce more balanced long and short stay parking places within Morpeth.

(OFF STREET PARKING PLACES – Ref TRO 019-004):- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Northumberland County Council have made the above-named Order under Sections 32, 35, and Paragraphs 20 and 27 of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order, which will come into force on the 21st November 2016 will be to introduce long stay parking in the south side of the town of Morpeth and short stay parking in the north side of the town of Morpeth in the County of Northumberland.

The following restrictions are added to the Principal Order, Off Street Parking Places Composite Order 2014.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may before the 30th December 2016 apply to the High Court for that purpose.
