Coming into Force: 1st April 2019

Northumberland County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 32, 35, 45 and 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984"), and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:

1. Commencement and Citation

This Order shall come into operation on the 1st April 2019 and may be cited as "Northumberland County Council North Northumberland (Northern) Area (Parking Places) Composite Order 2011 - Amendment No 16 Order 2019".

2. In the Order:-

"Order" means "Northumberland County Council North Northumberland (Northern) Area (Parking Places) Composite Order 2011".

"Amendment Order" means "NCC North Northumberland (Northern) Area (Parking Places) Composite Order 2011 - Amendment No 16 Order 2019".

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply to this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

3. Provisions

The following provisions set out below and in The Schedule to this Amendment Order shall be additions to, deletions from, or substitutions in the restrictions in the Order:

PART I – PRELIMINARY – 2. Interpretation

Deletion - “Northumberland County Wide permit” means a Permit issued by the Council in accordance with Article 11;

Deletion - “weekly tourist permit” means a Permit issued by the Council in accordance with Article 11;

Addition- “Northumberland Pay and Display Parking Permit” means a Permit issued by the Council in accordance with Article 11;

PART II – PARKING PLACES – 7.. Tickets, permits and vouchers, to be displayed on vehicles left in certain parking places

Deletion – (4) Pay and Display Parking Places

Save as provided in Article 17&19 at all times during which a Vehicle is left in a Pay and Display Parking Place as specified in Schedule 3, during the Permitted Hours, there shall be displayed on the said Vehicle a valid Ticket or

- (a) a valid Northumberland County Wide Parking Permit; or
- (b) a valid Weekly Tourist Permit

Or for more than the Permitted Hours:

- (i) a valid Resident's Permit;
- (ii) a valid Visitor's Permit;
- (iii) a valid Disabled Person's Badge; or
- (iv) a valid Parking Dispensation

displayed so that all the particulars of the Permit or Dispensation are readily visible from the front or near side of the Vehicle.

Addition – (4) Pay and Display Parking Places

Save as provided in Article 17&19 at all times during which a Vehicle is left in a Pay and Display Parking Place as specified in Schedule 3, during the Permitted Hours, there shall be displayed on the said Vehicle a valid Ticket or

(a) a valid Northumberland Pay and Display Parking Permit; or

Or for more than the Permitted Hours:

- (v) a valid Resident's Permit;
- (vi) a valid Visitor's Permit;
- (vii) a valid Disabled Person's Badge; or
- (viii) a valid Parking Dispensation

displayed so that all the particulars of the Permit or Dispensation are readily visible from the front or near side of the Vehicle.

PART III – SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS – Section 2 – Permits – 10.

Application for permits

Deletion –

(3) Northumberland County Wide Parking Permits

Any person may apply to the Council for the issue of a County Wide Parking Permit to facilitate the leaving of a Vehicle of a class specified in Article 6 in a On-Street Pay and Display Parking Place, during the permitted hours.

(4) Weekly Tourist Parking Permits

Any person may apply to the Council for the issue of a Weekly Tourist Parking Permit to facilitate the leaving of a Vehicle of a class specified in Article 6 in a On-Street Pay and Display Parking Place, during the permitted hours

Addition–

(3) Northumberland Pay and Display Parking Permits

Any person may apply to the Council for the issue of a Northumberland Pay and Display Parking Permit to facilitate the leaving of a Vehicle of a class specified in Article 6 in a On-Street Pay and Display Parking Place, during the permitted hours.

PART III – SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS – Section 2 – Permits – 11. Issue of permits

Deletion –

- (1) On receipt of an application made for a Residents Parking Permit under the foregoing provisions of Article 10 and upon being satisfied that the applicant is a Resident, the Council may issue to the applicant a Parking Permit of the requisite type for that Zone.
- (2) The annual charge of a Permit is:
 - (i) for a Residents Parking Permit is as specified in Schedule 7 to this Order.
 - (ii) for a Visitors Parking Permit is as specified in Schedule 7 to this Order.

- (iii) for a Northumberland County Wide Parking Permit is as specified in Schedule 7 to this Order.

Weekly Tourist Parking Permit

- (3) The weekly charge of a Permit is:
 - (i) for a Weekly Tourist Parking Permit is as specified in Schedule 7 to this Order.
- (4) The issue of any Permit shall be solely at the discretion of the Council.

Addition –

- (1) On receipt of an application made for a Residents Parking Permit under the foregoing provisions of Article 10 and upon being satisfied that the applicant is a Resident, the Council may issue to the applicant a Parking Permit of the requisite type for that Zone.
- (2) The annual charge of a Permit is:
 - (i) for a Residents Parking Permit is as specified in Schedule 7 to this Order.
 - (ii) for a Visitors Parking Permit is as specified in Schedule 7 to this Order.
 - (iii) for a Northumberland Pay and Display Parking Permit is as specified in Schedule 7 to this Order.
- (3) The issue of any Permit shall be solely at the discretion of the Council.

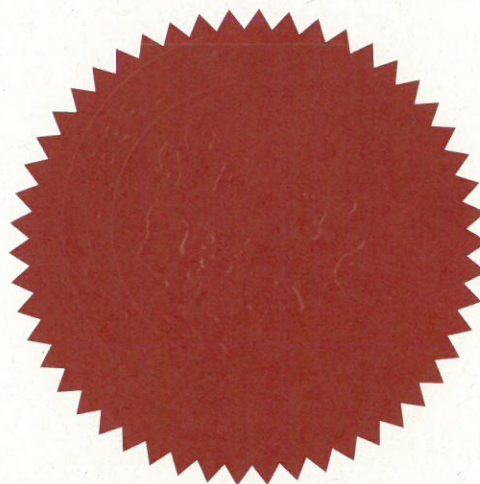

**STATEMENT OF THE COUNCIL'S REASONS FOR
MAKING THE ORDER**

The Order is necessary for the introduction of an amended Schedule 7 Tariffs for Permits - Northumberland County Council North Northumberland (Northern) Area (Parking Places) Composite Order 2011, the Primary Order.

This administrative change, will enable consistency with the method for other tariff charges for parking, i.e. on and off street parking charges.
