STATEMENT OF THE COUNCIL'S REASONS FOR MAKING THE ORDER

Mickley First School, Mickley

The new restrictions directly outside Mickley First School on the A695 West Road in the form of 'School Keep Clear' zig-zag markings are necessary in order to prevent any further vehicles from parking at the entrance gates to the school, thereby improving road safety by discouraging any further obstructive and discriminative parking, whilst improving visibility for pedestrians and motorists at school start and end times.

The new 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions on the A695 West Road and at its junction with Eastgate Bank are also required in order to limit any further obstructive parking which blocks access and egress into private residential driveways and to improve the flow of traffic for vehicles attempting to navigate through that junction, which is currently made difficult by vehicles parking at this location.
