CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

1. THE COUNCIL of the City of Norwich ("the Council") in exercise of its agency powers under an agreement made with the Norfolk County Council under Section 101 of the Local Government Act, 1972, makes this Order under Sections 1, 2, 4 and 45 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police.

This Order is made on the 10th day of November 2000 and shall come into force for all purposes on the 13th day of November 2000 and may be cited as "The Norwich City Council City Centre Controlled Parking Zone (No.1) Traffic Regulation Order 2000".

GENERAL

Interpretation

2.(1) All lengths of road specified in this Order are lengths of road in the City of Norwich.

2.(2) Where context allows the singular includes the plural and vice versa.

2.(3) Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended by any subsequent enactment.

Definitions

2.(4) In this Order the following words and phrases have the meanings ascribed to them as follows:-

"articulated vehicle" means a motor vehicle with a trailer so attached to it as to be partially superimposed upon it;

"coach"

"bus" has the same meaning as in Regulation 22 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994;

"bus stop clearway" means any of the areas of carriageway mentioned in Schedule 16 to this Order which are contained within a traffic sign being in accordance with diagram 1025.1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994;

"Charge" in connection with the issue of permits means the amount of the fee for the issue of a permit as is fixed from time to time by the Council;

"Disabled Person" means a person as defined in Regulation 5 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982;

"Disabled Person's Badge" has the same meaning as ascribed to it is Regulation 3(1) of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1982;

"Disabled Person's Vehicle" means a vehicle lawfully displaying a Disabled Persons Badge and which is a vehicle which, immediately before or after any period of waiting allowed by virtue of a provision of a kind required by Regulation 3 of the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England and Wales) Regulations 1986 to be included in an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, has been or is to be driven by a disabled person or, as the case may be, has been or is to be used for carrying disabled persons as passengers;

"driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place or if the identity of that person is not known to the Council the registered keeper of that vehicle;

"goods vehicle" has the same meaning as that ascribed to it in Section 192 of the Road Traffic Act, 1988;

"a heavy goods vehicle" means any goods vehicle which has an operating weight exceeding 7.5 tonnes;

"operating weight" of a goods vehicle is;

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- (a) in the case of a motor vehicle not drawing a trailer its maximum laden weight;
- (b) in the case of an articulated vehicle, its maximum laden weight (if it has one) and otherwise the aggregate maximum laden weight of all the individual vehicles forming part of that articulated vehicle, and
- (c) in the case of a motor vehicle (other than an articulated vehicle) drawing one or more trailers, the aggregate maximum laden weight of the motor vehicle and the trailer or trailers attached to it;

"a medium goods vehicle" means any goods vehicle which has an operating weight between 3.5 and 7.5 tonnes;

"registered keeper" in relation to a vehicle means the person recorded as keeping it, by the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Centre on behalf of the Secretary of State for Transport;

"household" means all persons resident at one postal address;

"Controlled Zone" means the roads or part of roads mentioned in Schedule 1 to this Order within which parking is controlled by this Order.

"Sub-Zone" means a part of the Controlled Zone;

"coach" means any vehicle designed to carry more than 16 persons excluding the driver.

(1) In this Order all times and days are inclusive.

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PART TWO : CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE AND SUB ZONES

SECTION ONE – WAITING RESTRICTIONS

WAITING OF VEHICLES

- 3.(1) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 2 at any time.
- 3.(2) No person shall cause or permit any vehicles to wait in the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 23 between 7.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday, any such day not being Christmas Day.
- 3.(3) Nothing in Articles 3(1) shall prevent a person causing or permitting a vehicle to wait if the vehicle is waiting with the permission of a Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden or is one or more of the categories A, B, C, E or F specified in this article as follows:-

A - means a vehicle which is being used to enable persons to board or alight from that vehicle;

B - means any vehicle which is, if it cannot be used for such purposes in any other length of road, being used in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any length of road, or the laying, erection, alteration or repair, in or near any length of road of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or any telecommunication apparatus;;

C - means any vehicle owned by a local government body which is being used in local government service provided that the vehicle cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other street;

E - means any vehicle being used for Police, Fire Brigade or Ambulance purposes, or in an emergency by a medical practitioner;

F - means any vehicle being used –

For the purpose of delivering or collecting postal packets, as defined in Section 87 of the Post Office Act 1953.

- 3.(4) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be loaded or unloaded in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 22 between 7.30 a.m. to 9.30 p.m. and 4.30 p.m. to 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive, any such day not being Christmas Day.
- 3.(5) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be loaded or unloaded in the lengths of road specified in Schedule 15 at any time.
- 3.(6) Nothing in Articles 3(1) shall apply to a Disabled Person's Vehicle should that vehicle be parked for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by

an interval of less than 1 hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle in the same road or part of a road on the same day) so long as that Disabled Person's Vehicle displays a Disabled Person's Badge together with a parking disc, issued by a local authority, 125mm square, coloured orange, and capable of showing the quarter hour period during which a period of waiting begins, and the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle, marks on the parking disc the time at which the period of waiting has begun.

PARKING PLACES

4.(1) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a coach to wait in the lengths or road mentioned in Schedule 32. Between the hours of 7.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on any day a coach waiting in any of the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 32 shall not wait for a period exceeding ten minutes and shall not return to the same length of road within sixty minutes of the ending of a previous period of waiting. After the hours of 6.30 p.m. and before 7.30 a.m. on any day there is no maximum waiting period. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle other than a coach to wait in the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 33 during the hours of 7.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. on any day. A coach waiting within this period may wait for a maximum of ten minutes and shall not return to the same area of highway within a period of 60 minutes from the end of any previous period of waiting. During the period 7.31 p.m. to 6.29 p.m any person may cause or permit any vehicles to wait in the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 33.

4.(2) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the areas of highway specified in Schedule 16 except that a person may cause or permit a bus to wait

- 4.(3) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 27 of this Order except for a period not exceeding 30 minutes for loading/unloading purposes on a day which is not Easter Sunday or Christmas Day. A vehicle which has waited in a length of road mentioned in Schedule 27 of this Order may not return to the place of previous waiting within 60 minutes of the previous waiting ending.
- 4.(4) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 28 of this Order during the hours of 7.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday and such day not being Christmas Day except a period not exceeding 30 minutes for the purpose of loading or unloading. During the period 6.31 p.m. to 7.29 a.m. any person may cause or permit a vehicle to wait in the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 28.

A vehicle which has waited in a length of road mentioned in Schedule 28 of this Order may not return to the place of previous waiting within 60 minutes of the previous waiting ending.

4.(5) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a police vehicle to wait in the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 29 at any time.

- 4.(6) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a vehicle displaying a green badge issue by the Council together with a disabled persons badge to wait in the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 30 at any time.
- 4.(7) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a vehicle displaying a disabled persons badge to wait in the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 31 at any time.
- 4.(8) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle other than a motorcycle to wait in the lengths of road mentioned in Schedule 36 at any time.
- 5. A Police Constable in uniform or a Traffic Warden may, in case of an emergency, move or cause to be moved any vehicle left in a Parking Place to any place they think fit.
- 6.(1) A person may allow a vehicle to wait in any of the streets or part of streets mentioned in Schedule 45 of this Order for a period not exceeding 30 minutes continuous waiting between the hours of 7.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday inclusive provided that the vehicle did not previously wait in the same road or length of road within two hours of the commencement of the period of waiting.
- 6.(2) A person may allow a vehicle to wait in any of the streets or part of streets mentioned in Schedule 45 of this Order for any period 6.31 p.m. to 7.29 a.m. on Monday to Saturday and at any time on Sundays and Christmas Day.
- 6.(3) Any person authorised by the Council, a Police Constable or a Traffic Warden may suspend the use of part or all of a Parking Place whenever (s)he considers a suspension reasonably necessary:-

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(a) for the purpose of facilitating the movement of traffic or promoting its safety;

(b) for the purpose of any building operation, demolition or excavation in or adjacent to the parking place or the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the parking place or the laying, erection, alteration, removal or repair in or adjacent to the parking place of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telegraphic line or traffic sign;

(c) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to or persons delivering to the parking place on any occasion of the removal of furniture from one office or dwelling house to another r the removal or delivery of furniture from such premises to a depository or to such premises from a depository;

(d) on any occasion on which it is likely that by reason of some special attraction any street will be crowded with people;

(e) for the convenience of occupiers of premises adjacent to the parking place at times of weddings or funerals.

6.(4)) Any person suspending the use of a Parking Place or of any part thereof in accordance with the provisions of Article 12(6) shall place or cause to be placed, in or

adjacent to that parking place or the part the use of which is suspended, a traffic sign indicating that waiting by vehicles is prohibited.

RESTRICTIONS ON THE USE OF A PARKING PLACE

- 7.(1) A driver of a vehicle shall not use a Parking Place so as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the road, or so as to prevent the use of the road by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance, or when the Council has closed that Parking Place.
- 7.(2) No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in a Parking Place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the Parking Place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his or her skill or services.

REMOVAL OF A VEHICLE FROM A PARKING PLACE

- 8.(1) When a vehicle is left in a Parking Place in contravention of any of the provisions contained in this Order, a person authorised by the Council to do so may remove the vehicle or alter its position or arrange for it to be removed from that Parking Place and shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.
- 8.(2) Any person removing a vehicle or altering its position by virtue of paragraph (1) of this Article may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as they may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as they may think necessary to enable them to remove it or alter its position, as the case may be.

REVOCATIONS

9. The orders specified in the Schedule marked 'Orders to be Revoked' are revoked to the extent specified in that Schedule and in so far as they extend to the streets mentioned in any other schedule to this order.


