1. Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as The City of Norwich (City Centre Controlled Parking Zone) (Amendment No 1) Traffic Regulation Order 2003 and shall come into effect for all purposes on the 18th day of June 2003.

- 2. The Norwich City Council City Centre Controlled Parking Zone (Consolidation) Traffic Regulation Order 2003 is amended as follows:-
- 3. Schedules 1b, 2, 4 15, 22, 23, 24, 27, 28, 29, 30,31, 315, 40, 42, 43, 44, 45,46,47, 48, 49 and 50 as amended as specified in the Schedules to this Order.
- 4. The definition of "permit holders parking place" is amended as follows:-

"permit holders parking place" means any part of a road specified in Schedules 4, 37, 38, 39, 40, 42, 43, 44, 80,81, 82, 84 and 85 to this Order during the hours specified in those Schedules as times when the areas noted are permit holders parking places.

- 5. The definition of "permit parking times" is amended as follows:-
 - "permit parking times" means the times mentioned in Schedules 4, 37, 38, 39, 40, 42, 43, 44, 80, 81, 82, 84 and 85 of this Order as times during which the lengths of road mentioned are permit holders parking places.
- 6. The following articles are added:-
 - 4(23) A person may cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the parts of streets mentioned in Schedule 80 to this Order during the period 7.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday, any such day not being Christmas Day, for a maximum time of 120 minutes, no return within 180 minutes.
 - 4(24) A person may cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the parts of streets mentioned in Schedule 81 to this Order during the period 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday, any such day not being Christmas Day, for a maximum of 240 minutes, no return within 240 minutes.
 - 4(25) A person may cause or permit a vehicle to way in any of the parts of streets mentioned in Schedule 82 to this Order during the period 7.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday, any such day not being Christmas Day, for a maximum time of 240 minutes, no return within 240 minutes.

1. Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as The City of Norwich (City Centre Controlled Parking Zone) (Amendment No 1) Traffic Regulation Order 2003 and shall come into effect for all purposes on the 16th day of June 2003.

- The Norwich City Council City Centre Controlled Parking Zone (Consolidation) Traffic Regulation Order 2003 is amended as follows:-
- 3. Schedules 1b, 2, 4 15, 22, 23, 24, 27, 28, 29, 30,31, 315, 40, 42, 43, 44, 45,46,47, 48, 49 and 50 as amended as specified in the Schedules to this Order.
- 4. The definition of "permit holders parking place" is amended as follows:-

"permit holders parking place" means any part of a road specified in Schedules 4, 37, 38, 39, 40, 42, 43, 44, 80,81, 82, 84 and 85 to this Order during the hours specified in those Schedules as times when the areas noted are permit holders parking places.

5. The definition of "permit parking times" is amended as follows:-

"permit parking times" means the times mentioned in Schedules 4, 37, 38, 39, 40, 42, 43, 44, 80, 81, 82, 84 and 85 of this Order as times during which the lengths of road mentioned are permit holders parking places.

- 6. The following articles are added:
 - 4(23) A person may cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the parts of streets mentioned in Schedule 80 to this Order during the period 7.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday, any such day not being Christmas Day, for a maximum time of 120 minutes, no return within 180 minutes.
 - 4(24) A person may cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the parts of streets mentioned in Schedule 81 to this Order during the period 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday, any such day not being Christmas Day, for a maximum of 240 minutes, no return within 240 minutes.
 - 4(25) A person may cause or permit a vehicle to way in any of the parts of streets mentioned in Schedule 82 to this Order during the period 7.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday, any such day not being Christmas Day, for a maximum time of 240 minutes, no return within 240 minutes.

- 4(26) A person may cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the parts of streets mentioned in Schedule 83 to this Order during the period 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday, any such day not being Christmas Day, for a maximum time of 240 minutes, no return within 240 minutes. A person may cause any vehicle to wait in any of the parts of streets mentioned in Schedule 83 outside the time specified in this article without limit of time.
- 4(27) A person may cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the part of the streets mentioned in Schedule 84 to this Order during the period 8.00 a.m. to 10.00 p.m. Monday to Saturday, any such day not being Christmas Day, for a maximum time of 120 minutes, no return within 180 minutes. A person may cause any vehicle to wait in those parts of streets mentioned in Schedule 84 on Christmas Day and at any time on a Sunday without limit of time.
- 4(28) A person may cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the parts of streets mentioned in Schedule 85 to this Order during the period 7.30 a.m. to 6.30 p.m. Monday to Saturday, any such day not being Christmas Day, for a maximum time of 30 minutes, no return within 60 minutes.
