(CITY CENTRE CONTROLLED PARKING ZONE)

(PEDESTRIAN ZONES WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS) AMENDMENT TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2009

The City Council of Norwich pursuant to an agency agreement with the Norfolk County Council under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 and in exercise of the powers of the Norfolk County Council under sections 1, 2, 4, 45 and 46 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling provisions hereby makes the following Order: -

1. Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as the Norwich City Council (City Centre Controlled Parking Zone) (Pedestrian Zones Waiting and Loading Restrictions) Amendment Traffic Regulation Order 2009 and shall come into effect for all purposes on the 12th day of October 2009.

- 2. The Norwich City Council City Centre Controlled Parking Zone (Consolidation) Traffic Regulation Order 2003 (as amended) is amended by the addition of Schedules, 110, 111 and 112 in respect of loading and unloading restrictions as specified in Articles 3, 4 and 5 of this Order.
- 3. Article 3(8)(a) as added by the Norwich City Council (Rose Lane) (Waiting Restrictions) Traffic Regulation Order 2004 is deleted.
- 4. The following Articles are added as Articles 3(8)(a), (b), (c) and (d):-
 - "3(8)(a) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be loaded or unloaded in the areas of highway specified in Schedule 110 between the hours of 10:00am to 5:00pm on any day except Easter Sunday and Christmas Day.
 - 3(8)(b) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be loaded or unloaded in the areas of highway specified in Schedule 111 between the hours of 11:00am to 4:00pm Monday to Friday and 10:00am to 5:00pm Saturday, Sunday and Christmas Day.
 - 3(8)(c) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be loaded or unloaded in the areas of highway specified in Schedule 112 between the hours of 11:00am to 4:00pm on any day.
 - 3(8)(d) Nothing in Articles 3 (8a), 3 (8b) and 3 (8c) shall prevent any person from causing or permitting any vehicle to load or unload on lengths of the road referred in those Articles if it is being used for the following purposes:-

- in an emergency by a medical practitioner or for fire brigade, ambulance, police or civil defence purposes;
- (ii) in conjunction with any building operation or demolition;
- (iii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
- (iv) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of any of the lengths of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or telecommunications provided the vehicle cannot be conveniently used for such purpose in any other road;
- (v) postal service deliveries and collections;
- (vi) enable access for a marked bullion vehicle to load or unload its contents to or from premises adjoining the said lengths of road for the time necessary to carry out said act;
- (vii) used to collect refuse from or otherwise to service the Provision Market and authorised to do so by Norwich City Council;
- (viii) handcart;
- (ix) mechanical vehicle propelled by pedestrian.
- 5. The following Articles are added as Articles 3(9)(i), (ii) and (iii) :-
 - "3(9) (i) Nothing in Article 3(8)(a) shall apply to a vehicle whilst it is being used in the lengths of road referred to in Schedule 110 in connection with a funeral or wedding being held at St Peter Mancroft Church;"
 - (ii) Nothing in Article 3(8)(b) shall apply to a vehicle whilst it is being used in the lengths of road referred to in Schedule 111 in connection with a funeral or wedding;
 - (iii) Nothing in Article 3(8)(c) shall apply to a vehicle whilst it is being used in the lengths of road referred to in Schedule 112 in connection with a funeral or wedding.
- 6. Schedules 110, 111 and 112 are added as specified in Schedules 110, 111 and 112 of this Order.
