NORWICH CITY COUNCIL (FOULGERS OPENING) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2009

The City Council of Norwich pursuant to an agency agreement with the Norfolk County Council under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 and in exercise of the powers of the Norfolk County Council under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation 1984 and all other enabling provisions hereby makes the following Order: -

1. Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as the Norwich City Council (Foulgers Opening) Prohibition of Driving) Traffic Regulation Order 2009 and shall come into effect for all purposes on the 1st day of August 2009.

2. Definitions

"emergency vehicle" means a vehicle engaged on Fire Brigade, Police, Ambulance Service, Bomb Disposal Service or National Blood Service emergency business.

3. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle top proceed in that length of Foulgers Opening from a line between its southern junction with Ber Street to a point 5 metres west of that line.

4. <u>Exemptions</u>

Nothing in Article 3 above shall make it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in this part of the street mentioned in Article 2 provided that the vehicle is:-

- (a) an emergency vehicle; or
- (b) a pedal cycle.
