

NORWICH CITY COUNCIL (SOUTHERN AREA)
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING) (DUCKETT CLOSE)
AMENDMENT TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2008

The City Council of Norwich pursuant to an arrangement made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the Norfolk County Council and in exercise of the powers of the Norfolk County Council under Sections 1, 2, and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers hereby makes the following Order:-

1. Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as the “Norwich City Council (Southern Area) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Duckett Close) Amendment Traffic Regulation Order 2008” and shall come into effect for all purposes on the 1st day of December 2008.

2. The Norwich City Council (Southern Area) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Consolidation) Traffic Regulation Order 1982 (as amended) is amended by the addition of Duckett Close in Schedules 2, 57 and 64 as specified in Schedules 2, 57 and 64 of this Order.

Schedule No 2 No Waiting At Any Time

Duckett Close – *Insert the following new provision*

Both sides from its junction with Barrett Road to a point 5.5 metres north-east of the boundary of Nos. 1/2 Duckett Close

Schedule No 57 No Stopping On School Entrance Markings At Any Time

Duckett Close – *Insert the following new provision*

The west side from a point 6.5 metres south-west of the boundary of Nos. 18/19 Duckett Close to a point opposite and 10 metres south-east of the boundary of Nos. 5/6 Duckett Close

Schedule No 64 No Waiting, Monday to Friday, 8 a.m. to 6.30 p.m.

Duckett Close – *Insert the following new provisions*

- (i) the east side from a point opposite the boundary of Nos. 18/19 Duckett Close to a point 5 metres north-west of the boundary of Nos. 5/6 Duckett Close
- (ii) the west side from the boundary of Nos. 18/19 Duckett Close for a distance of 6.5 metres in a south-westerly direction
