

**NORWICH CITY COUNCIL**  
**(BERTRAM WAY) (PEDESTRIAN AREA)**  
**TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER 2011**

The City Council of Norwich pursuant to an agency agreement with the Norfolk County Council under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 and in exercise of the powers of the Norfolk County Council Sections 1, 2, 4 and 122A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all enabling provisions hereby makes the following Order :-

1. **Citation and Commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Norwich City Council (Bertram Way) (Pedestrian Area) Traffic Regulation Order 2011 and shall come into effect for all purposes on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of September 2011.

2. **Definitions**

“cycle” has the same meaning as in Section 192 of the Road Traffic Act 1988;

“civil enforcement officer” has the same meaning as in Section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004;

“emergency vehicle” means a being used by a medical practitioner, the Fire Brigade, Police, Ambulance, national blood service, bomb or explosive disposal or civil defence purposes, whilst on emergency business;

3. Save as provided for in Articles 3 and 4 of this Order, no person shall, except upon the direction of a Police Constable in uniform or civil enforcement officer, drive or propel, or cause or permit to be driven or propelled any vehicle at any time on the entire length of Bertram Way from its junction with Rosary Road (“the pedestrianised area”).

4. Nothing in Article 3 above shall make it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to be driven or propelled in the pedestrianised area provided the vehicle is -

- (a) a cycle;
- (b) an emergency vehicle;
- (c) a motorised disabled persons cart being used by a disabled person;
- (d) a handcart;
- (e) a vehicle controlled by a pedestrian;

or if the vehicle is being used :

- (f) in the service of a local authority or water authority or gas or electrical supplier in pursuant of statutory powers or duties;
- (g) in connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement, or reconstruction of any lengths of road or of any sewer or of any main, pipe, or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or telecommunications apparatus as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
- (h) to enable goods or merchandise to and from premises adjoining, or with access from the pedestrianised area to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (i) in connection with the provision of a universal postal service as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000;
- (j) for the collection of refuse;
- (k) to gain access to or egress from the designated on-street parking places and park the vehicle therein.
- (l) being used to access or egress private parking areas;
- (m) in connection with a funeral.
