NORWICH CITY COUNCIL (MOUNTERGATE) (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2013

The City Council of Norwich pursuant to an agency agreement with the Norfolk County Council under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 and in exercise of the powers of the Norfolk County Council under sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation 1984 and all other enabling provisions hereby makes the following Order: -

Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as the Norwich City Council (Mountergate) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2013 and shall come into effect for all purposes on the 13th day of May 2013.

2. <u>Prohibition of Driving</u>

No person shall, except upon the direction of a police constable, traffic warden in uniform or uniformed officer of the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in Mountergate at its junction with King Street.

Exemptions

Nothing in Article 2 above shall make it unlawful for any person to cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in Mountergate at its junction with King Street provided that the vehicle is –

- (i) a pedal cycle;
- (ii) a motor vehicle engaged on emergency business for the Fire Brigade, Police, Ambulance, bomb or explosive disposal or the national blood service.
- 4. The Norwich City Council (Mountergate) (One Way Traffic and Banned Right Turn) Traffic Regulation Order, 1991 is amended by the deletion of Article 1 and the Schedule referring to the one-way travel in Mountergate are hereby deleted.
- 5. The Norwich City Council (King Street) (One Way) Traffic Regulation Order 2003 is amended by the deletion of Article 3 insofar as it relates to one-way travel in King Street is hereby deleted.

6. Insofar as any provision of any previous Order conflicts with any provision of any previous Order relating to the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order, that provision of this Order shall prevail.
