NORWICH CITY COUNCIL HALL ROAD - CONVERSION OF FOOTPATH INTO SHARED FOOTPATH AND CYCLE TRACK ORDER 2016

The Norwich City Council pursuant to its powers under an agency agreement with the Norfolk County Council and in exercise of its powers, under Section 3 of the Cycle Tracks Act 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the "Norwich City Council Hall Road Conversion of Footpath into Footpath and Cycle Track Order 2016".
- 2. The lengths of footpaths set out in (i) and (ii) below are declared to be unsegregated cycle track/footpath for use by persons travelling on foot or by pedal cycle:-
 - (i) from the existing unsegregated cycle track/footpath to the front of the ASDA store, just south of the junction with Robin Hood Road to connect with the existing unsegregated cycle track/footpath that commences just south of the junction with Fountains Road;
 - (ii) from the existing unsegregated cycle track/footpath that ends opposite the entrance to the Holiday Inn, southwards to the junction with Old Hall Road with the existing unsegregated cycle track/footpath that commences just south of the junction with Fountains Road.
