

**THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(MAIN STREET AND EPPERSTONE ROAD, LOWDHAM)**  
**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITIONS) ORDER 2020 (NK169-20)**

**WHEREAS** the Nottinghamshire County Council (hereinafter called "the Council") being the traffic authority for the length of highway referred to in Articles 1 and 2 of this Order is satisfied that the use of the said length of highway should be restricted by reason of the works proposed to be executed in or near the said highway.

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, hereby makes the following Order in respect of roads at **Lowdham** in the District of **Newark and Sherwood**: -

1. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the following length of road: -
  - a) **Epperstone Road, Lowdham – for its entire length.**
  - b) **Main Street, Lowdham – for its entire length.**
  - c) **Ton Lane, Lowdham – between its junctions with Main Street and A6097 Lowdham Bye Pass.**
  - d) **The Leys, Lowdham – from its junction with Epperstone Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 25 metres.**
  - e) **Nursery Gardens, Lowdham - from its junction with Main Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 25 metres.**
  - f) **The Priors, Lowdham - from its junction with Main Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 25 metres.**
  - g) **Francklin Road, Lowdham - from its junction with Main Street in an easterly direction for a distance of 25 metres.**
  
2. No person shall cause any vehicle to stop, both sides, at any time in the following lengths of road:-
  - a) **Epperstone Road, Lowdham – for its entire length.**
  - b) **Main Street, Lowdham – for its entire length.**
  
3. Nothing in Article 1 of this Order shall apply so as to make it unlawful for any vehicle to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the said Article for the purposes of access to or egress from premises, provided that the said access or egress may only be gained by proceeding over the length of road specified in the said Article, provided that the works being carried out would not be inconveniently interrupted.
  
4. No prohibition, restriction or prescription contained in this Order shall apply to any vehicle being used for
  - police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes
  - proceeding at the direction, or with the permission of, a police constable
  - being used in connection with the said works.
  
5. Any existing restrictions, prohibitions previously introduced by an order made under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 will be temporarily suspended for so long as this order is in force and traffic signs are in place.
  
6. In this Order “works” means works being carried out by or on behalf of Nottinghamshire County Council.

7. For so long as, and to the extent that, traffic signs (authorised under the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions in force on the date this Order is made) indicating the effect of the prohibition contained in Article 1 and 2 of this Order is placed, that prohibition shall be enforced.
8. This Order may be cited as "The Nottinghamshire County Council (Main Street and Epperstone Road, Lowdham) (Temporary Prohibitions) Order 2020 (NK169-20)" and shall come into force on the **19<sup>th</sup>** day of **October 2020** and continue until the works are complete.
