THE OLDHAM BOROUGH COUNCIL (OLDHAM AREA/CHADDERTON AREA/CROMPTON AREA/FAILSWORTH AREA/LEES AREA/ROYTON AREA AND SADDLEWORTH AREA) CONSOLIDATION ORDERS 2003 AMENDMENT No 170 ORDER 2018

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2), 4(2), 32, 35, 45, 46 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order made on 16th February 2018 shall come into operation on 23rd February 2018 and may be cited as the Oldham Borough Council (Oldham Area/Chadderton Area/Crompton Area/Failsworth Area/Lees Area/Royton Area and Saddleworth Area) Consolidation Orders 2003 Amendment No 170 Order 2018
- 2. The Oldham Borough Council (Chadderton Area) Consolidation Order 2003, the Oldham Borough Council (Crompton Area) Consolidation Order 2003, the Oldham Borough Council (Failsworth Area) Consolidation Order 2003, the Oldham Borough Council (Council (Lees Area) Consolidation Order 2003, the Oldham Borough Council (Royton Area) Consolidation Order 2003 and the Oldham Borough Council (Saddleworth Area) Consolidation Order 2003 ("the Principal Orders") shall be amended by the insertion of the additional definitions and Articles and the amendment of the existing definitions and Articles as detailed in Schedule 1 to this Order from the date of this Order
- 3. This Order shall be construed as one with the Principal Orders.

SCHEDULE 1

AMENDMENTS TO THE PRINCIPAL ORDERS

Insert the following wording after paragraph (18) of the Definitions section of the Principal Orders:

- (18A) "Electric Vehicle" means a vehicle that is powered in part or in full by a battery that can be directly plugged into mains electricity, including pure-electric, plug-in, hybrid and extended range electric vehicles;
- (18B) "Electric Vehicles' Charging Place" means a Parking Place or Parking Bay marked in accordance with the requirements of Schedule 7 part 4 item 6 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

Amend paragraph (31) of the Definitions section of the Principal Orders to read as follows:

(31) "Parking Place" means (subject to Sections 2, 3, 4, and 5 of Part II of this Order) any area of highway authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place or as an Electric Vehicles' Charging Place.

Amend paragraph (32) of the Definitions section of the Principal Orders to read as follows:

(32) "Parking Bay" means any part of the Parking Place (including an Electric Vehicles' Charging Place) marked out by white lines or otherwise for the leaving of a vehicle.

Amend the preamble to Section 4: Parking Places (Off Street) to read as follows:

In this Section of Part II of this Order, the expressions "Parking Place" and "Parking Bay" also incorporate Electric Vehicles' Charing Place as defined in Article 18B and refer only to those areas of land authorised under Article 25 of Part II of this Order.

Insert the following wording at Article 40 of the Principal Orders:

40. No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be parked in a Parking Place which is an Electric Vehicles' Charging Place unless the vehicle is an Electric Vehicle which is being recharged and is clearly attached to the recharge post using the appropriate cable.

Amend Article 48(a)(v) of the Principal Orders to read as follows:

v. The driver of the vehicle does not use the Parking Place for its proper purposes in contravention of Articles 29, 31, 32, 32A, 35, 36, 38, 39 and 40, or

Amend the preamble to Section 5: Parking Places (On Street Pay and Display) to read as follows:

In this Section of Part II of this Order, the expressions "Parking Place" and "Parking Bay" also incorporate Electric Vehicles' Charing Place as defined in Article 18B and refer only to those areas of highway authorised under Article 68 of Part II of this Order.


Insert the following wording after Article 72 of the Principal Orders:

72A No person shall cause or permit a vehicle to be parked in a Parking Place which is an Electric Vehicles' Charging Place unless the vehicle is an Electric Vehicle which is being recharged and is clearly attached to the recharge post using the appropriate cable.
