ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE OLDHAM – HAREWOOD DRIVE ROYTON AREA 20MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER
2021

The Oldham Borough Council, in exercise of their power under section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order made on 18th October 2021 may be cited as the Oldham – Harewood Drive Royton Area 20mph Speed Limit Order 2021 and shall come into force on 25th October 2021
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

20MPH SPEED LIMIT ORDER

<u>Roads Affected</u>	<u>Length</u>
Chiltern Drive	From both its junctions with Denbydale Way for its full length, a distance of 255 metres
Longdale Close	From its junction with Camberwell Way to its cul-de-sac end, a distance of 100 metres
Camberwell Way	Its full length between Denbydale Way junctions, a distance of 120 metres
Chetwyn Avenue	From its junction with Denbydale Way to all 3 cul-de-sac ends, a distance of 320 metres
Brantwood Close	From its junction with Denbydale Way to its cul-de-sac end, a distance of 54 metres
