## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

## THE OLDHAM LEES AREA (WOODHEAD CLOSE) CONSOLIDATION ORDER EXPERIMENTAL PROHIBITION OF WAITING ORDER 2024

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Section 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following order: -

- 1. This Order made on 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2024 shall come into operation on 10<sup>th</sup> September 2024 and may be cited as the Oldham Lees Area (Woodhead Close) Consolidation Order Experimental Prohibition of Waiting Order 2024 and will continue in force until 9<sup>th</sup> March 2026.
- 2. The Executive Director for Economy, Skills and Places for Oldham Borough Council may, if that officer considers it essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs, and after consulting with the Chief Officer of Police, modify or suspend this Order, or any provision thereof, at any time.
- 3. The Oldham Lees Area Consolidation Order 2003 the "Principal Order" shall have effect as though the waiting restrictions detailed in Schedule below are included in the Principal Order for the period of this Order
- 4. This Order shall be construed as one with the Principal Order.
