ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE OLDHAM - BURNLEY LANE (CHADDERTON) PROHIBITION OF WAITING AMENDMENT EXPERIMENTAL ORDER 2001

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. The Order shall come into operation on 22nd January 2001 and may be cited as the Oldham - Burnley Lane (Chadderton) Prohibition of Waiting Amendment Experimental Order 2001 and will continue in force until 21st January 2002.
- 2. The Chadderton (Burnley Lane) (Traffic Regulation) (No.3) Order, 1973 (which Order is hereinafter referred to as the "Principal Order") shall have effect as though the entries contained in Schedule 1 below be deleted from Schedule 1 to the Principal Order and the entries contained in Schedule 2 below be introduced into Schedule 1 to the Principal Order.
- 3. This Order shall be construed as one with the Principal Order.

4. The Executive Director, Environment and Transportation for the Oldham Borough Council or any person authorised by him, if it appears to him or that person to be essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, and after:-

- (i) consulting the Chief Constable of Greater Manchester Police, and
- (ii) giving such public notice as the Secretary of State may direct,

may make modifications of any description to this Order (other than additions) or suspend it.

The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any enactment.

To the north east of Fitton Park, the north easterly side from a point opposite 328 Burnley Lane, for a distance of 175 yards to its junction with the slip road now leading to Chadderton Way.

To the north west of Fitton Park, the north westerly side, from a point opposite 374 Burnley Lane, for a distance of 83 yards to a point opposite 388 Burnley Lane.

From a point 10 metres south of the junction with the access road at the gable of 350 Burnley Lane to a point 10 metres north of that junction.

From a point 10 metres south of its junction with the access road at the gable of 370 Burnley Lane to a point 40 metres north of that junction.
