ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE OLDHAM - ROMAN ROAD (ROYTON) PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ORDER 2002

The Oldham Borough Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) and 2(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

- 1. This Order shall come into operation on the 10th June 2002 and may be cited as the Oldham Roman Road (Royton) Prohibition of Stopping Order 2002.
- 2. No person shall, except on the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, a traffic warden or a parking attendant authorised by the Local Authority, cause or permit any vehicle to stop on the school entrance markings in the length of road, between the hours and on the days specified in the Schedule below.
- 3. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.



Roman Road, Royton	From a point 40 metres north west of its junction with Oldham Road for a distance of 40 metres in a north westerly direction	South West
